

the direction of close friend and Norristown Area High School head coach Roger Grove. During those years, Norristown won back-to-back Suburban One Conference Championships.



STEVE WILMOT


Offensive Line/Strength Coach


Linebacker Coach

Take Route 413 North to Route 202 South. Route 202 South to Route 313 West. Route 313 West to 5th Street in Perkasie (Approximately 25 minutes). Turn left onto 5th Street. High School is ½ mile on the right. Game will be played at the Poppy Yoder Field located at Pennridge Middle School in Perkasie just off 5th Street past the Pennridge High School.
