There, he was instrumental in implementing the Run & Shoot offense, which was nationally ranked during his last three seasons. As Recruiting Coordinator, Schmidt was no stranger to the Suburban One Conference, actively recruiting high school players throughout Southeastern Pennsylvania, Southern New Jersey and Delaware.

Prior to Lock Haven, Schmidt coached under Jerry Berndt at Temple University and the University of Pennsylvania. At Penn the team earned Ivy League Championship honors both seasons he was there. He also was a Tight End Coach under Jerry Claiborne at the University of Kentucky.

Schmidt's first coaching experiences actually came in the Suburban One Conference, when in 1982 and 1983, he coached under the direction of close friend and Norristown Area High School head coach Roger Grove. During those years, Norristown won back-to-back Suburban One Conference Championships.

A Graduate of Lower Moreland High School, Schmidt earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education from Ursinus College, where he was an All-Conference linebacker. Schmidt currently resides in Plymouth Meeting, PA, with his wife Maribeth and their daughter Erica, born February 26, 1997.



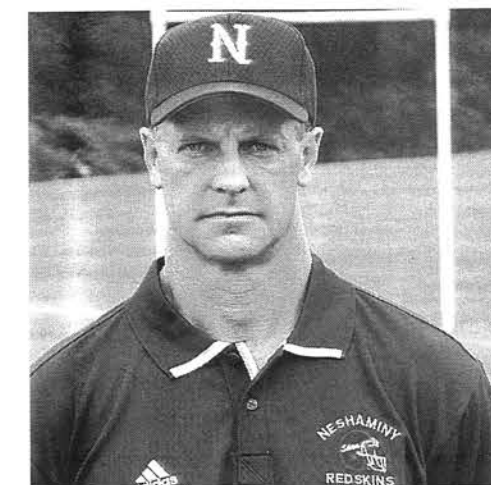

Offensive Line/Strength Coach



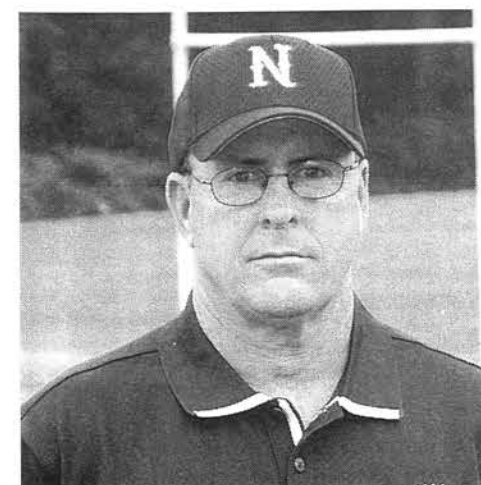

Defensive Backs



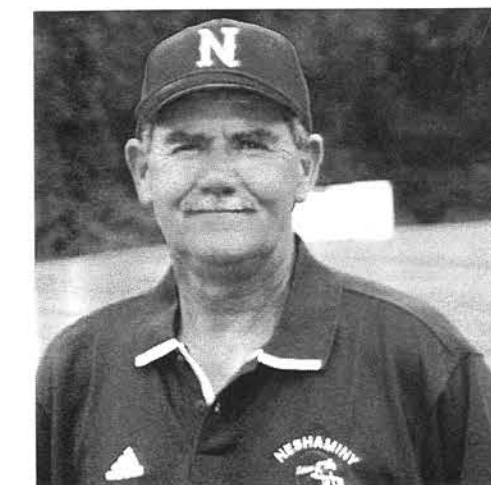

**RYAN O'NEAL**

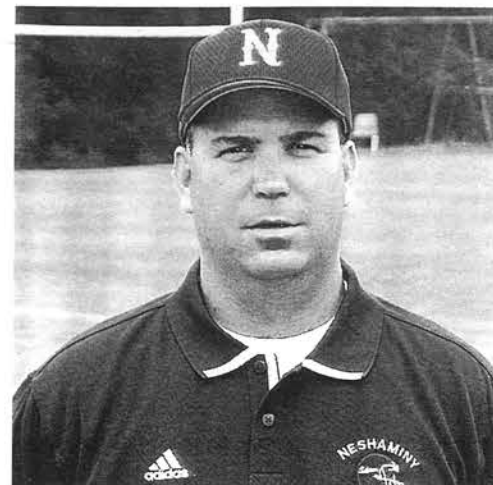
Running Back Coach

**NEIL FRENCH**

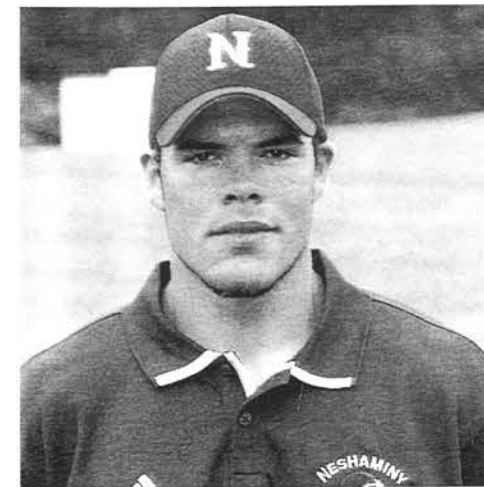
Linebacker Coach

## Directions to Away Games

### Pennridge High School

Take Route 413 North to Route 202 South. Route 202 South to Route 313 West. Route 313 West to 5<sup>th</sup> Street in Perkasio (Approximately 25 minutes). Turn left onto 5<sup>th</sup> Street. High School is ½ mile on the right. Game will be played at the Poppy Yoder Field located at Pennridge Middle School in Perkasio just off 5<sup>th</sup> Street past the Pennridge High School.

### Central Bucks West High School

CB East football games are held at War Memorial. Take Street Rd West to Rte 611 North to the Chalfont exit (Doylestown Hospital & Rte 202 South). Make a left off the ramp onto State St. The 1<sup>st</sup> road on the right after the light at the hospital will be Memorial Drive and the field will be on the left.

### Glen Mills

Take the PA turnpike to Mid-County Interchange. Follow Route 476 South (Blue Route) to Exit 5 (Springfield/Lima). Take Route 1 South to Cheyney Road. Make a right onto Cheyney Road. Go to the 3<sup>rd</sup> stop sign and make a right onto Glen Mills Road. Go about 1 mile on Glen Mills Road to The Glen Mills School is on the left.

### Pennsbury

Take Route 1 North to Oxford Valley Exit. Turn right onto Oxford Valley Road. Cross Business Route 1 and bear left on Oxford Valley Road. Take Oxford Valley Road (which becomes Levittown Pkwy) to Hood Blvd. Turn left onto Hood Blvd. School is on the left.
