



Schmidt's first coaching experiences actually came in the Suburban One Conference, when in 1982 and 1983, he coached under


the direction of close friend and Norristown Area High School head coach Roger Grove. During those years, Norristown won back-to-back Suburban One Conference Championships.

COACHING STAFF STEVE WILMOT


Offensive Line/Strength Coach

DANIEL KELLY


Running Back Coach


PAUL COLEMAN Defensive Line


Administrative Assistant

NEIL FRENCH


Linebacker Coach
