

### STEVE WILMOT


Assistant Head Coach Line/Strength Coach


### **RAY JONES**

### LEARN THE LINGO

Field Goal - A place kick from the line of scrimmage that goes over the crossbar between the uprights of the opponent's goal post. It is worth three points.

Fumble - When a ball carrier drops the ball on the field. The team first to recover the ball gains possession. If the defense recovers the fumble it is a "turnover".

Interception - When a forward pass is caught by a defender. (A turnover)

**Sack** - When defensive players tackle the quarterback behind the line of scrimmage, resulting in a loss of yards.

Tackle - When a ball carrier is taken down or stopped by an opposing player.

**Touchdown** - When a player carries the ball across the opposing goal line, or catches the ball or recovers a fumble in the end zone. A touchdown is worth six points.
