

A "special" thank you goes out to our award winning band, dedicated cheerleaders and all of our booster organizations. Without these people, we would never experience the success we have achieved.


Our "N" Club is to be commended for their year round efforts to support our football program and I encourage all to enjoy some of the wonderful "goodies" at our snack bar.







JAY WEIDENBAUGH








ROGER GROVE


ED DENTON Defensive Coordinator


NESHAMINY HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND 2006-2007
