

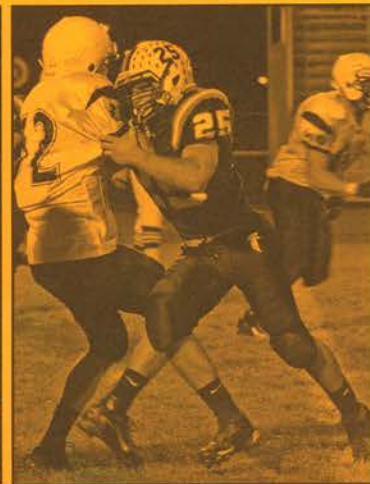

FROM THE PRINCIPALS

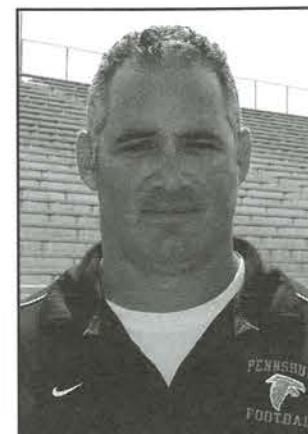

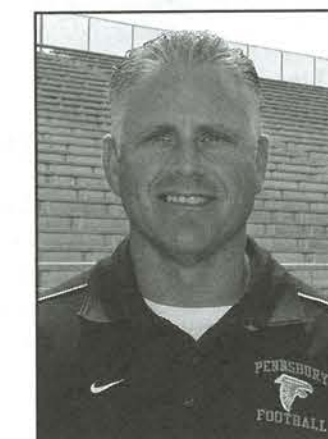


Jeff Arndt OFFENSIVE RUNNING BACKS

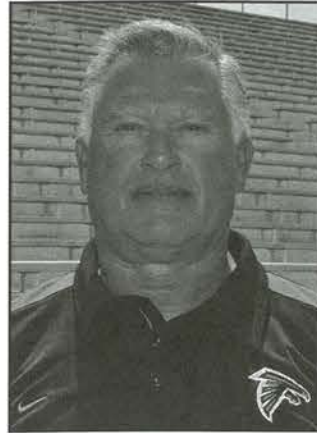

Robert Burns **DEFENSIVE LINE & SPECIAL TEAMS**

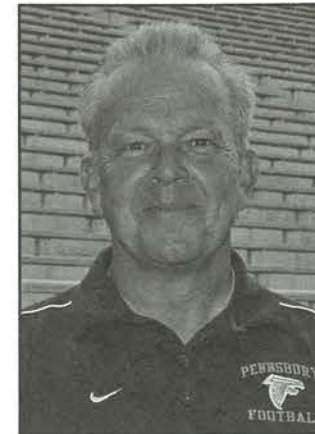

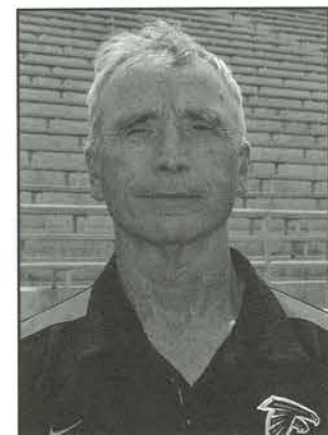


Mike Elko **DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

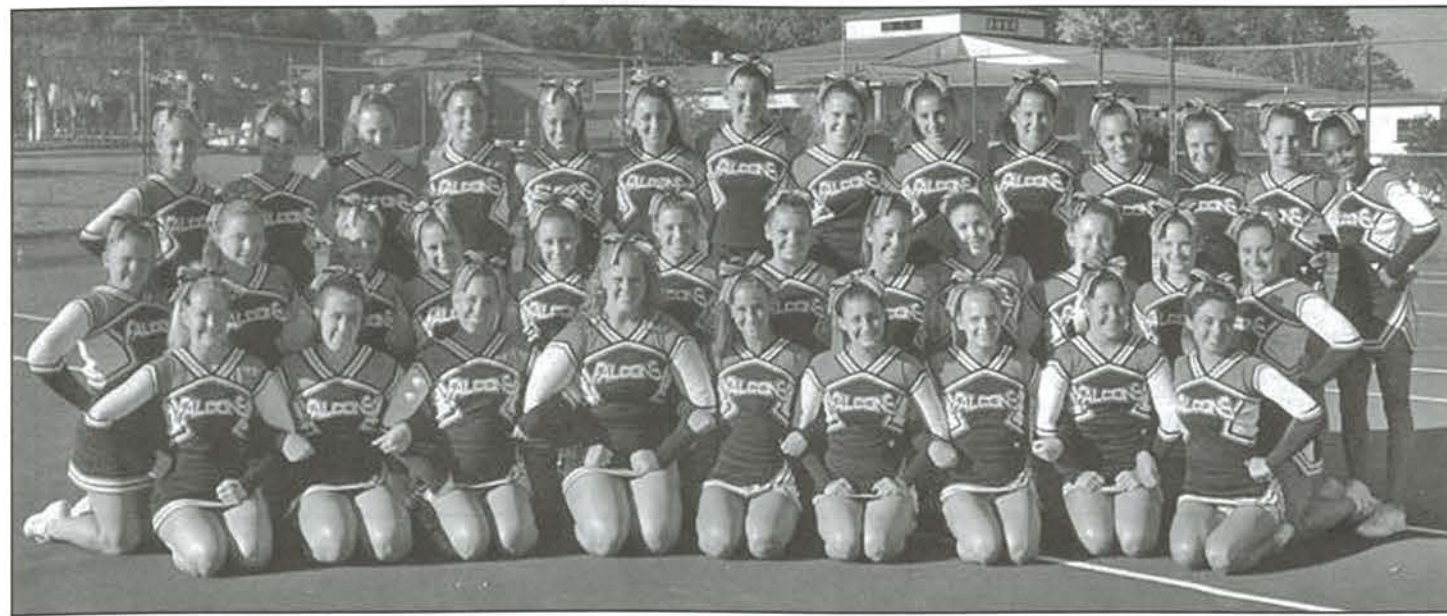
Harry S. Truman: Start out going East on Hood Blvd. toward Warwick Rd. Turn right on New Falls Rd. (about 1.6 mi.) Turn slight left onto Bristol Emile Rd. (about 1.1 mi.). Turn left on to Green Lane. 3001 Green Lane.

Bensalem: Start out going East on Hood Blvd. toward Warwick Rd. Turn right on New Falls Road (about 4.9 mi.). New Falls Rd. becomes Bridge Rd. Turn left on Bensalem Blvd. Turn right on Gibson Rd. Turn left onto Hulmeville Rd. / PA-513. 4319 Hulmeville Rd.

Abington: Take the PA Turnpike West to the Willow Grove exit. Merge left onto Route 611 South. Take 611 South (which changes names to York Rd.). Pass Abington Memorial Hospital to Susquehanna Rd. There is a light at the intersection, a YMCA is on the corner and a bank on the left. Make a right onto Susquehanna Rd. Go to the 2nd light which is Jericho Rd. and turn left, you'll see Abington Jr. High. Follow the road around to the right to reach the stadium.

2009 marks the 60th Anniversary of the Pennsbury High School Long Orange Line Marching Band! The Pennsbury Marching Band is internationally recognized as one of the premier High School Marching Bands in the United States. In March of 2008 the "Long Orange Line" was the featured halftime performers at the International Rugby Tournament "Hong Kong Sevens" in Hong Kong China. The Hong Kong Sevens was the Long Orange Line's largest audience in its 60 year history in which they performed in front of 40,000 people live and 50 million people via television throughout Asia, New Zealand, Europe and Australia. The Long Orange Line has the distinction of being the only Band on the planet to have performed at all five Walt Disney Theme Parks including Orlando, Florida; Anaheim, California; Tokyo, Japan; Paris, France; and Hong Kong, China. The band has the honor of being the only foreign musical ensemble to perform at Beijing's Tiananmen Square, and also upon the Great Wall in the People's Republic of China. The Pennsbury Marching Band has performed for numerous events for the Philadelphia Phillies, Eagles, and 76ers. The Long Orange Line on Thanksgiving Day, 2009 will have performed for 26 consecutive years as the Honor Band for the IKEA Channel 6, Thanksgiving Day Parade.
