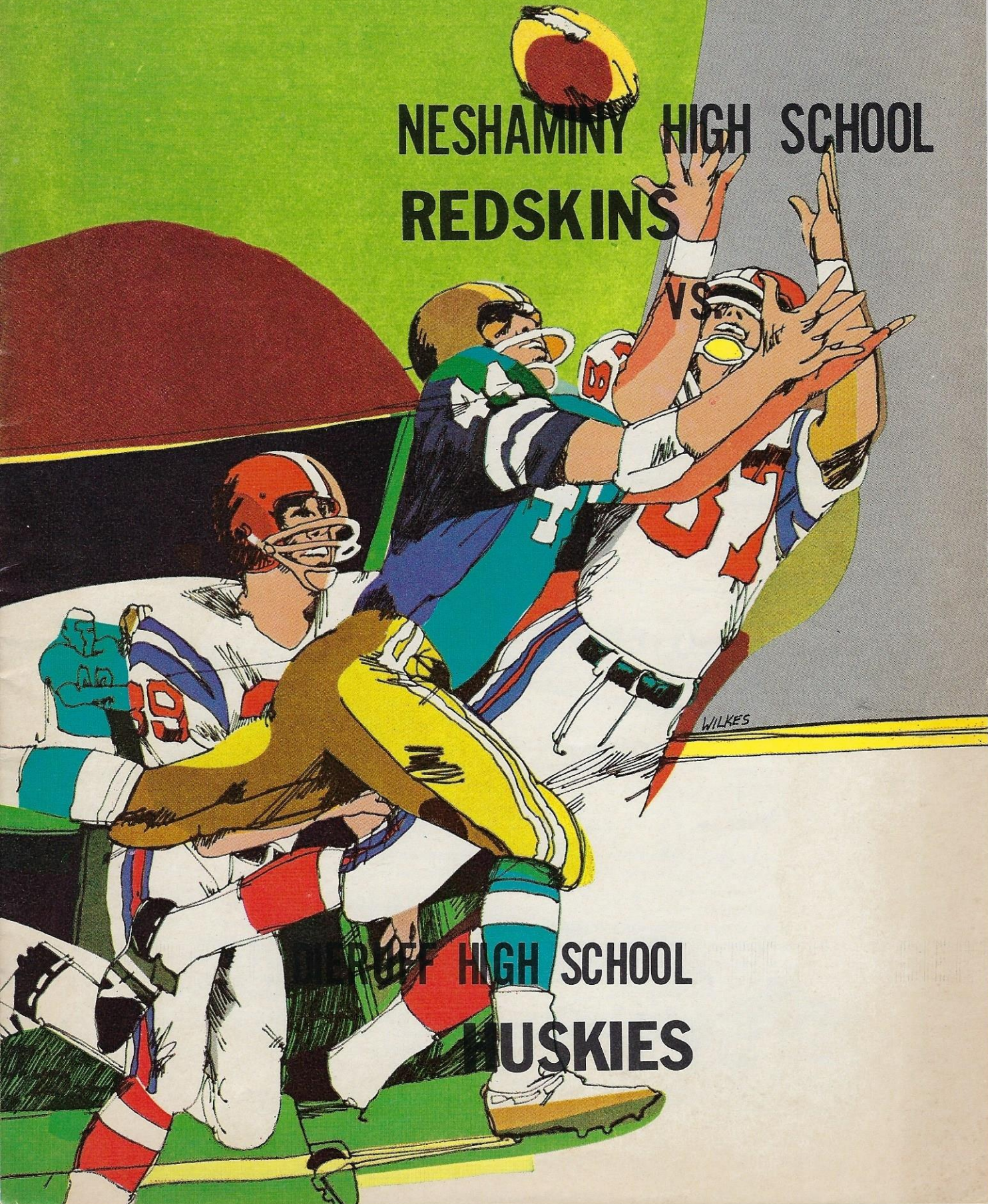

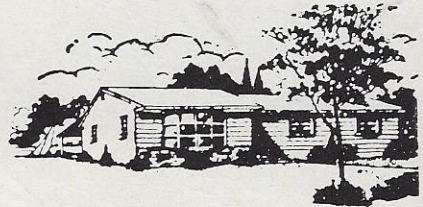

## FOUR WINS — FOUR HONORS

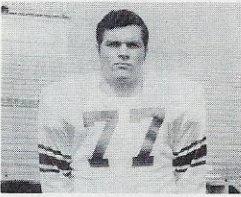
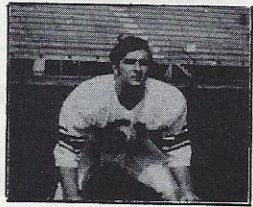
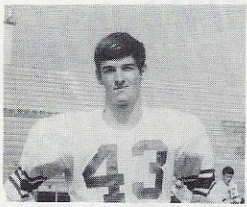

**JIM CAMPBELL** — gave a stellar performance from his defensive halfback position against Bishop Egan. By virtue of his outstanding "blanket job" he was selected as "Player of the Game" by TV Channel 7B.

**MIKE EMANUEL** — premier linebacker and defensive leader of the Savages, Mike has been nominated for the "Big 33" game and was selected as "Lineman of the Week" by the Bucks County Courier Times.

## TIME OUT

### "FOUR DOWN — SEVEN TO GO"

- No. 1 - BISHOP EGAN — Fell to the Redskins by a 17-0 score as the defensive "Savages" effectively throttled the Eagles attack to lead the way to an opening victory.
- No. 2 - PENNRIDGE — Found the offensive "Warriors" attack too much to handle as the 'Skins backs scored early and often to seal win number two by a 33-6 margin.
- No. 3 - EASTON — Wilted in the 95<sup>o</sup> heat and Redskin pressure as they melted under an afternoon sun by a score of 23-6 for the 'Skins opening win in the Big Seven conference.
- No. 4 - WM ALLEN — The previously unbeaten Canaries took an early 6-0 lead but the Redskins roared back and won going away by the score of 26-6.

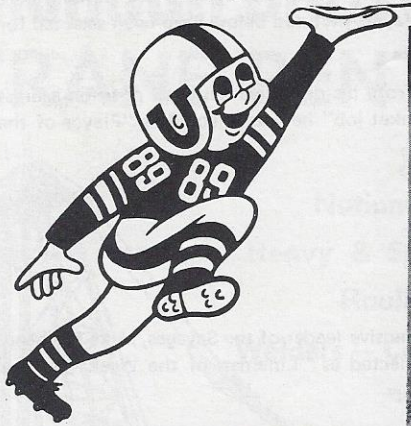
"Hello Huskies" - Louis Dieruff H. S. of Allentown moves into the Redskin reservation tonight. As with three of their first four opponents, the 'Skins face another undefeated opponent. Dieruff fields a veteran outfit that has won three straight this season. Most of the Huskies were part of a 16-6 win over the Redskins last season and they will be out to prove it was no accident. However, Neshaminy also fields a team composed of many players who suffered through that same game last season. Coach Swartz prefers to concentrate on the game at hand even while his record matches that of the "Huskies" coach.
