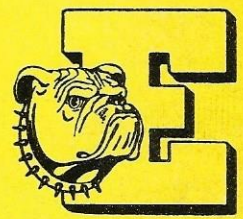

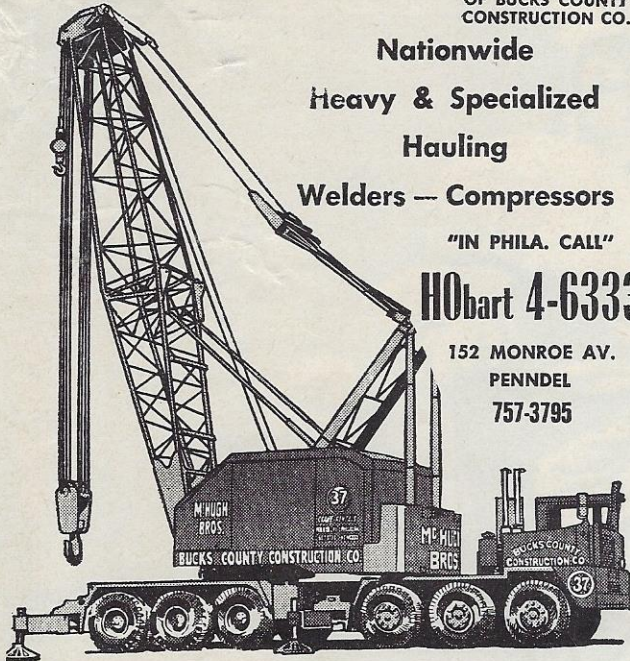

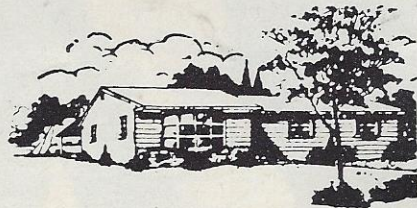

After a sluggish first half the 'Skins caught fire and scored often to down the Rams 46-14;

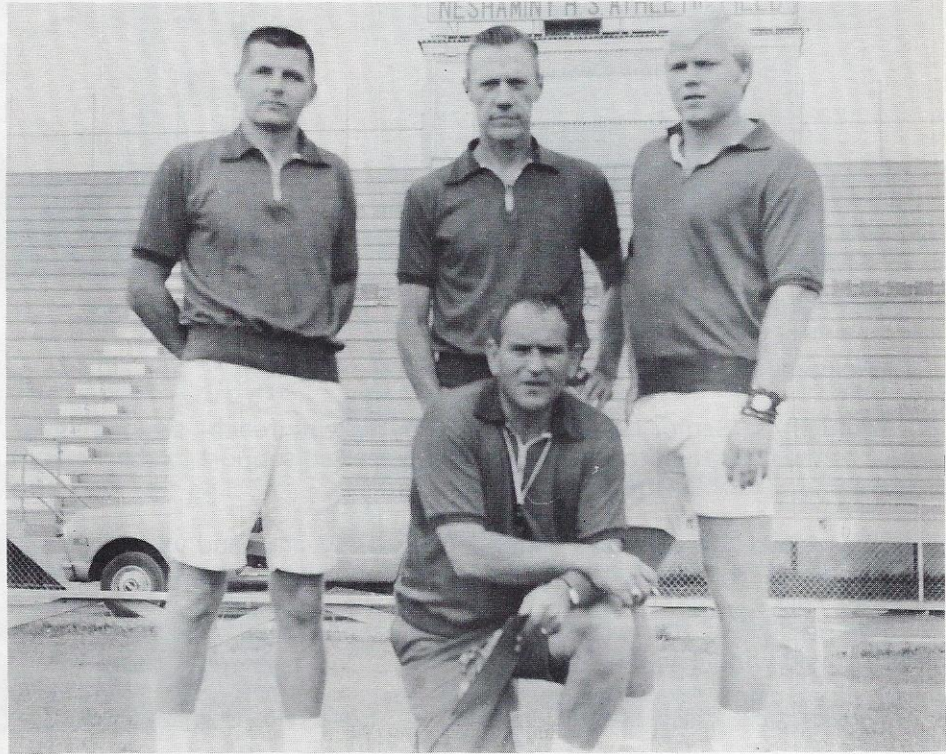
