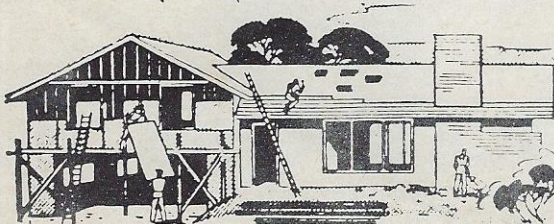

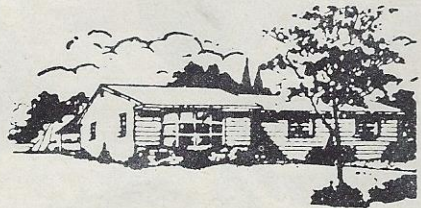

No. 1 - BISHOP EGAN -

With the Owls having problems this year, the Skins had little difficulty in rolling to a 49-0 L.B.C. win.

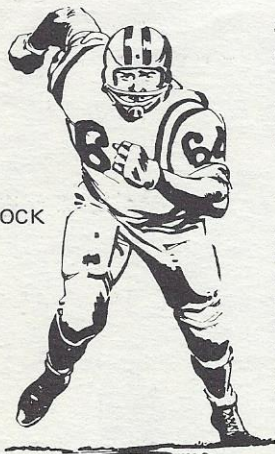
No. 8 - WILSON -

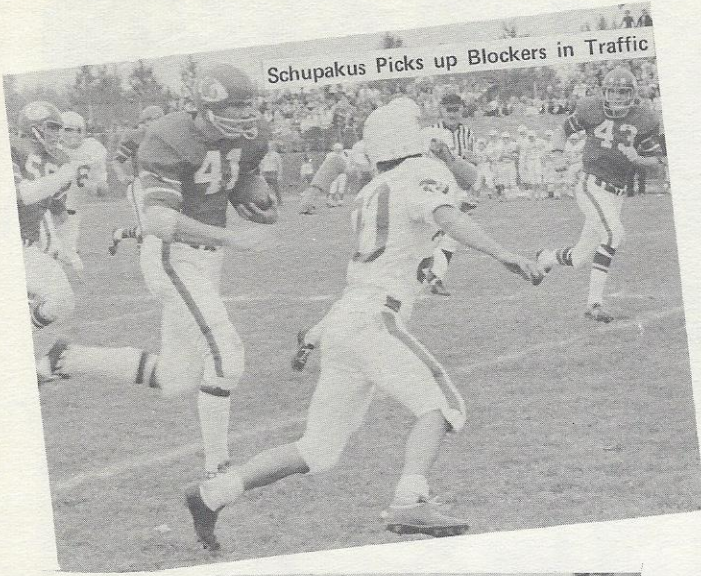

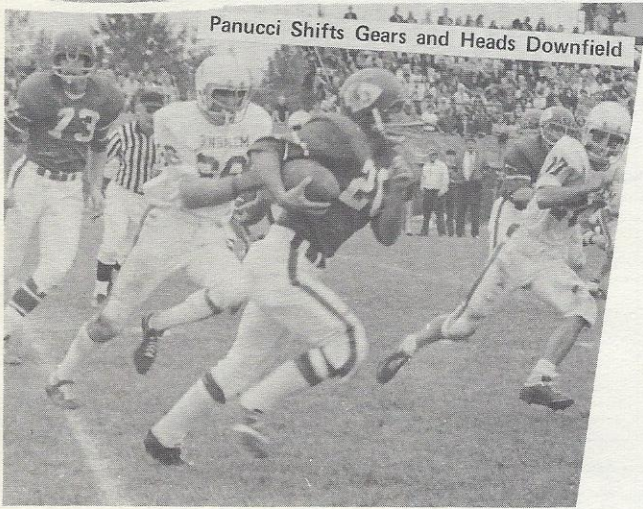
Schupakus Picks up Blockers in Traffic



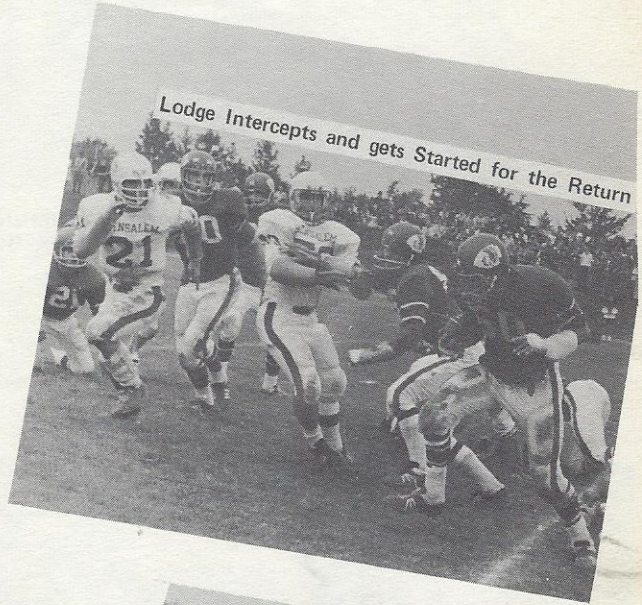

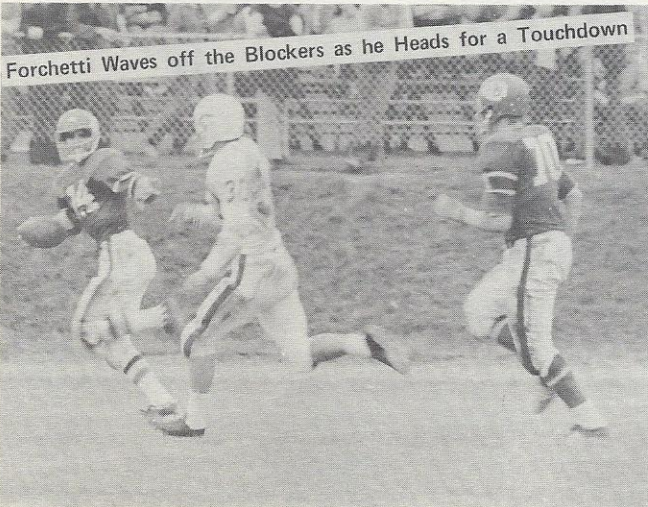
Panucci Shifts Gears and Heads Downfield



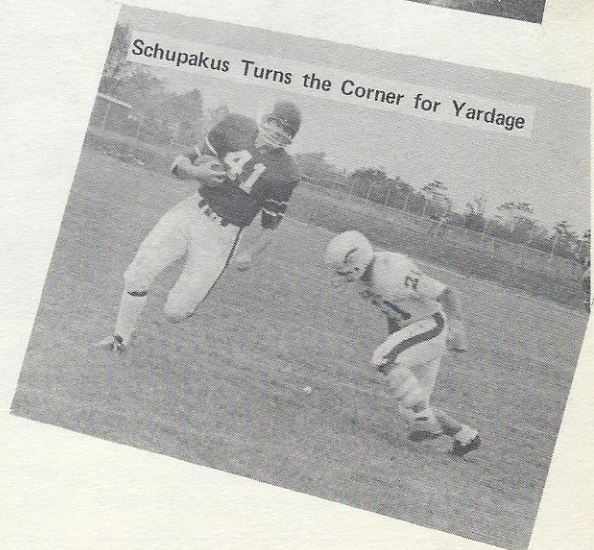
Lodge Intercepts and gets Started for the Return

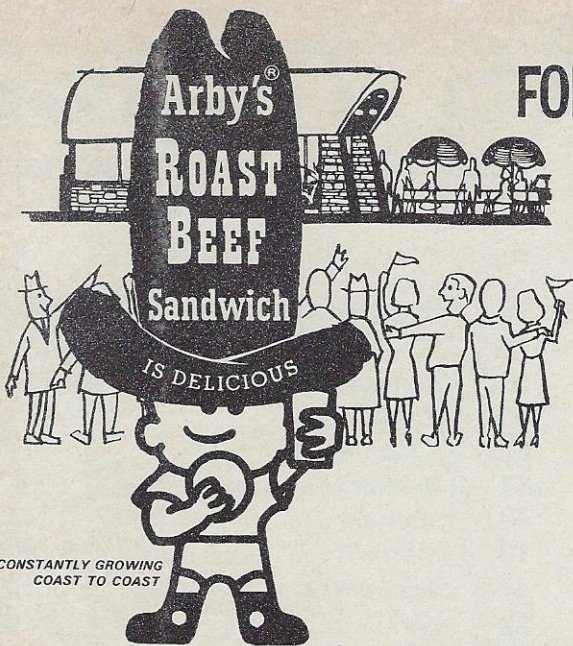
