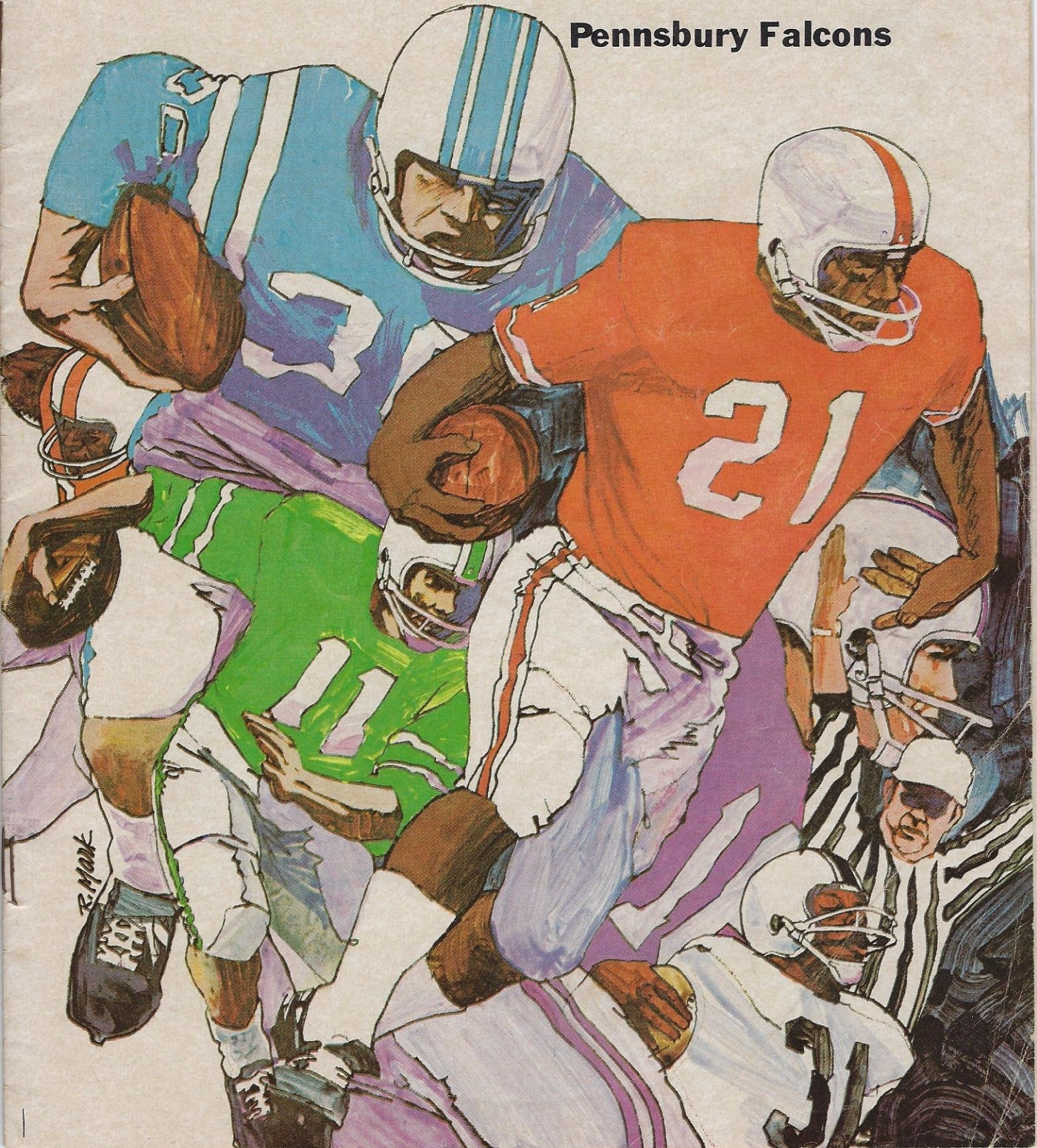

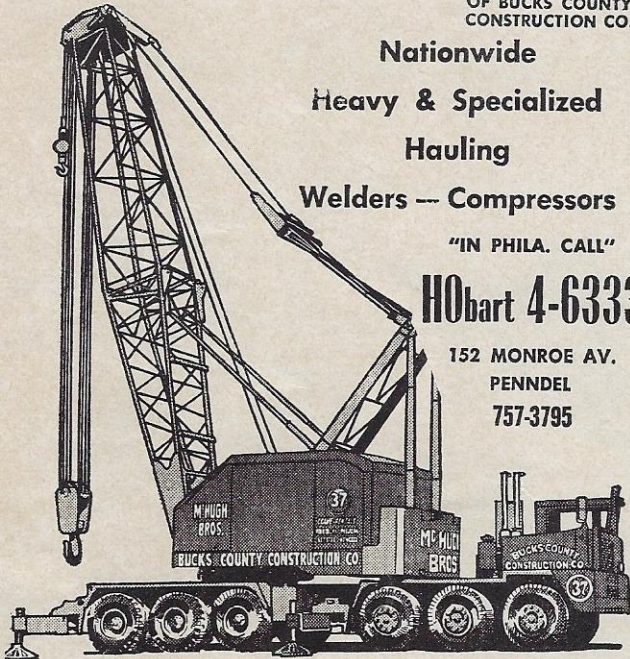

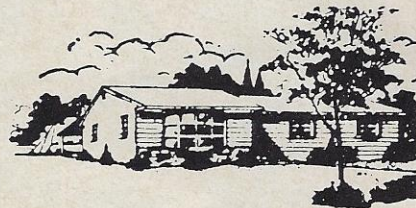

No. 1 - BISHOP EGAN -

Once again the Skins stumbled through the first half only to explode in the second half for a 34-8 triumph.

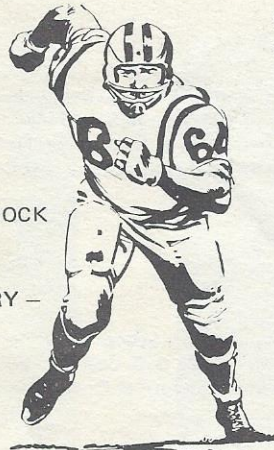
No. 10 - COUNCIL ROCK
