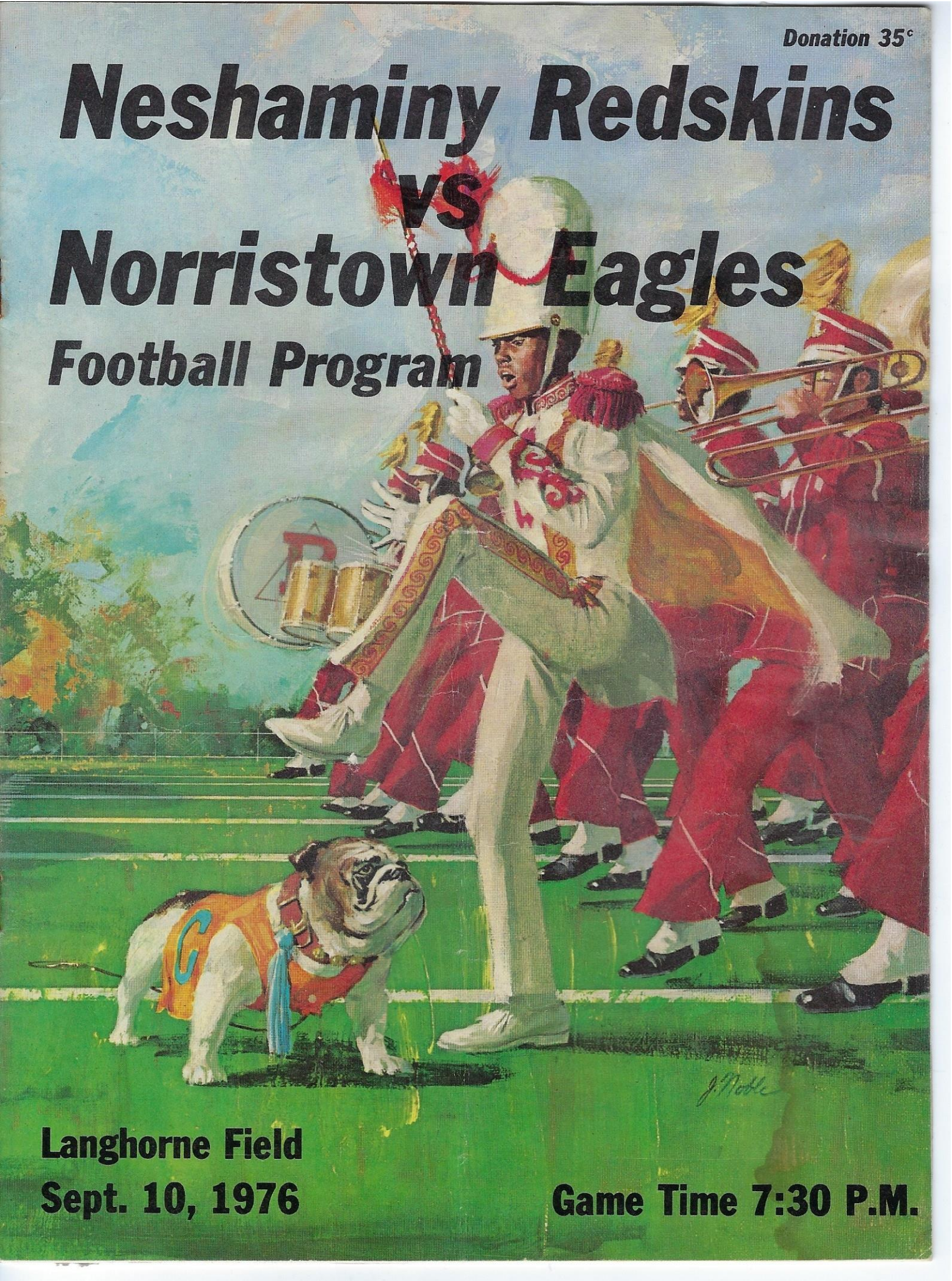



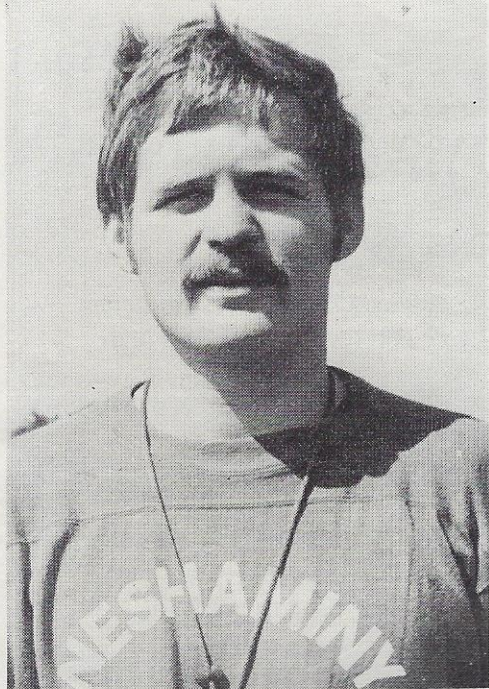

Head Coach Charles Schmidt is a veteran of four seasons on the Neshaminy Varsity coaching staff. After serving as an assistant under Jack Swartz for one year, and Pat Allison for three years, Charlie has taken the reins of the Redskins this year.

Charlie's coaching experience is enhanced by the seasons he spent playing on the offensive line for the West Chester College Golden Rams, where he majored in Health and Physical Education. From 1965 to 1968, Coach Schmidt was opening holes for Neshaminy High running backs.

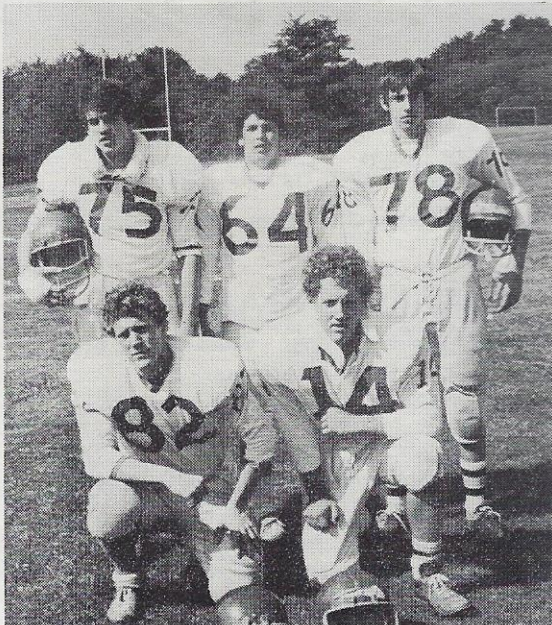
When not planning strategy for an upcoming game, Coach Schmidt finds his other duties as sophomore phys. ed. instructor, Physical Fitness Team Coach, and Ski Club advisor both challenging and fulfilling. Charlie's interest in physical fitness has led him to explore the physical training philosophies in other parts of the world. Recently, the Redskin Head Coach visited the People's Republic of China with twenty-two other Bucks County teachers to observe that country's educational programs. Prior to this, trips to western Europe and various Communist Bloc nations expanded Coach Schmidt's knowledge in the field of Comparative Physical Education.
