

# Johns and Daenz Lead Neshaminy to 20-12 Win

PERKASIE, Pa. — Neshaminy, with 5-7 pepperfoot Craig Johns and Bill Daenz doing most of the work, gave coach Pete Cordelli his first victory as the Redskin chief here last night, 20-12 over Penridge.

The Skins (1-1) spotted the host Rams a 6-0 lead in the opening minutes of the game when sophomore Jeff Eakin ran a punt back 95 yards.

But Cordelli's chargers didn't give up and on the very next kickoff, Steve Sroba, also a soph, raced 90 yards to send the Neshaminy rooters in the crowd of 6,000 into pandemonium.

Johns scored his first of two touchdowns in the second period on a six-yard run which climaxed a 71-yard drive that started in the first quarter. Daenz picked up 46 yards in the drive.

The clock showed 11:26 to go in the game when the final Johns' TD came on a five-yard run. Johns not only scored twice, but chewed up 23 of Neshaminy's yards and also made a recovery of teammate Bob Magill's fumble to keep the

drive alive. Craig Vosburgh was successful on two out of three extra point attempts for Neshaminy.
