

# Taking a look at PIAA football playoff contenders

AAA, or AAAA) of the opponent as well as the outcome of the game.

If each school wins all of its remaining games, they will reach the potential point total. Only one team from each region qualifies for the playoffs.

An excellent example of the importance of potential points is the AAAA classification. Currently, Coatesville has 65 points and is leading the AAAA schools in points. Ridley, which has played one fewer game, has a lower point total (59) right now. But if Ridley wins its last 2 games, the Green Raiders would reach their potential points (67) and be the AAAA representative in the state playoffs.

The PIAA ratings system works like this: Each team receives 4 points for a victory, 2 for a tie and 0 for a loss. In addition, bonus points are awarded for victories; 4 points for beating a AAAA team, 3 points for beating a AAA team, 2 points for beating a AA team and 1 point for beating a A team.

To attain a maximum point total,

teams count only 9 of their 11 games. However, among the 9 games, teams must include all losses and ties. The team that finishes the season with the highest point total is the region's representative in the state playoffs.
