

C.B. East's Pats just a few points from a big year

Central Bucks East is 6-4 this year but a mere 14 points from being undefeated.

Consider the record:

Friday, Sept. 1 — Wilkes Barre Coughlin 16, C.B. East 14.

The Patriots lead, 14-0, in the third quarter but Coughlin capitalized on a two short punts to make the score 14-10 entering the fourth quarter. With less than 2 minutes to play the C.B. East punter drops the snap and Coughlin goes in to score the winning touchdown with 5 seconds to play.

Thursday, Sept. 28 — Neshaminy 17, C.B. East 14.

Again the Patriots lead, 14-0, in the third quarter but quarterback Mike Morelli, with the score 14-7, is forced to leave the game on the first play in the fourth quarter because of leg cramps after he moved the team to the Neshaminy 24-yard line. Neshaminy ties the game, on a 67-yard pass and wins it with just under 4 minutes to play on a field goal by Mike Ramos. Without Morelli the Patriots never again cross midfield.
