
Air Cornelius

For the first time in recent memory, there were five 1,000-yard passers in the Suburban One League this season, led by Neshaminy's Cornelius White who threw for 1,874 yards and 17 touchdowns. Taking second was Harry S Truman's Tim Tucker (1,518 yards), followed by Central Bucks East's Mike Morelli (1,361), Council Rock's Carl Albrecht (1,253) and Central Bucks West's Greg Moylan (1,033).

Tucker's accomplishment stands out, however, because he quarterbacked a lowly 1-10 club that, until Thanksgiving Day, had lost 27 straight ball games. The other league top passers played on clubs that, at one time or another, challenged for their respective Suburban One Patriot and Colonial League titles.

Archbishop Wood's Brian Lafond led all passers in the Catholic League North with 1,172 yards passing. Had Lafond been throwing in the Suburban One, he would have been ranked fifth.
