Center-linebacker Kevin Kelly and interior lineman Bill Foster, both of Neshamy, were second-team picks on both units.

In the business meeting Charles Kline, the Liberty principal, was named president of the Big 8 to succeed John McHugh, the Allen principal. Bruce Clymer of Dieruff was named vice president. The league will disband as of December, 1975.

The championship trophy went to Pennington coach Chuck Kane, whose team finished 7-0, while plaques were awarded to Roland Kyle, the retired principal of Reading, and Charles Steinbach, the retired athletic director at Freedom.
