SOCCKER REDSKINS PREPARE FOR DEFENSE OF 1968 CROWN

The 1969 edition of the Neshaminy Redskin soccer team has been hard at work since August 25 in preparation for the defense of its 1968 Lower Bucks County Soccer League Championship. Along with this accomplishment the 1968 soccer Redskins attained the first undefeated, untied season in the history of Neshaminy High School, with a record of 17 wins, 0 losses, and 0 ties under first year coach Heffelfinger. Upon completion of regular season play the soccer Redskins entered District 1 playoff competition, making it to the finals before being eliminated by Lower Merion. This loss, coupled with a win against Ridley High School in the semi-final round made the Redskins final season record 18 wins, 1 loss, and 0 ties.

Missing from the 1969 squad, due to graduation, will be such outstanding players as All-Lower Bucks selectees Scott Frazier and Rich Allen, goalie Alan Hackney, fullback George Merty, outside Dennis Jones, Fran Pultro, Gary Yehle, David Lindley, Dave Baranek, and John Muller. The following lettermen will return to form the nucleus of the 1969 soccer Redskins: co-captains Bruce Allen and Steve DuGan, Rich Armour, Chris Bahr, Bob Cappiello, Steve Guyger, Steve Perestam, George Topcion, Mark Tyma, and Bob Whitaker. This nucleus plus an excellent J.V. team, which turned in a 16 wins, 1 loss, 0 ties record under assistant coach John Smithgall, should provide plenty of opposition this year.

This year's soccer Redskins have a formidable task to perform in defense of their 1968 crown with a tough seventeen game schedule. It is hoped that with the support of the student body and with hard work the 1969 soccer Redskins can accomplish their task.

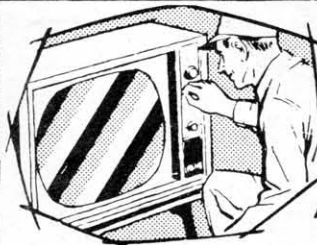

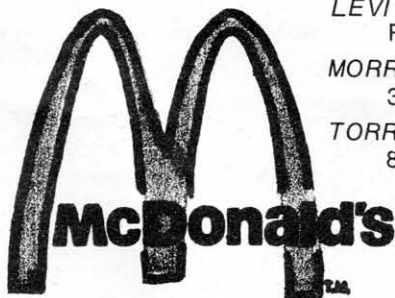
