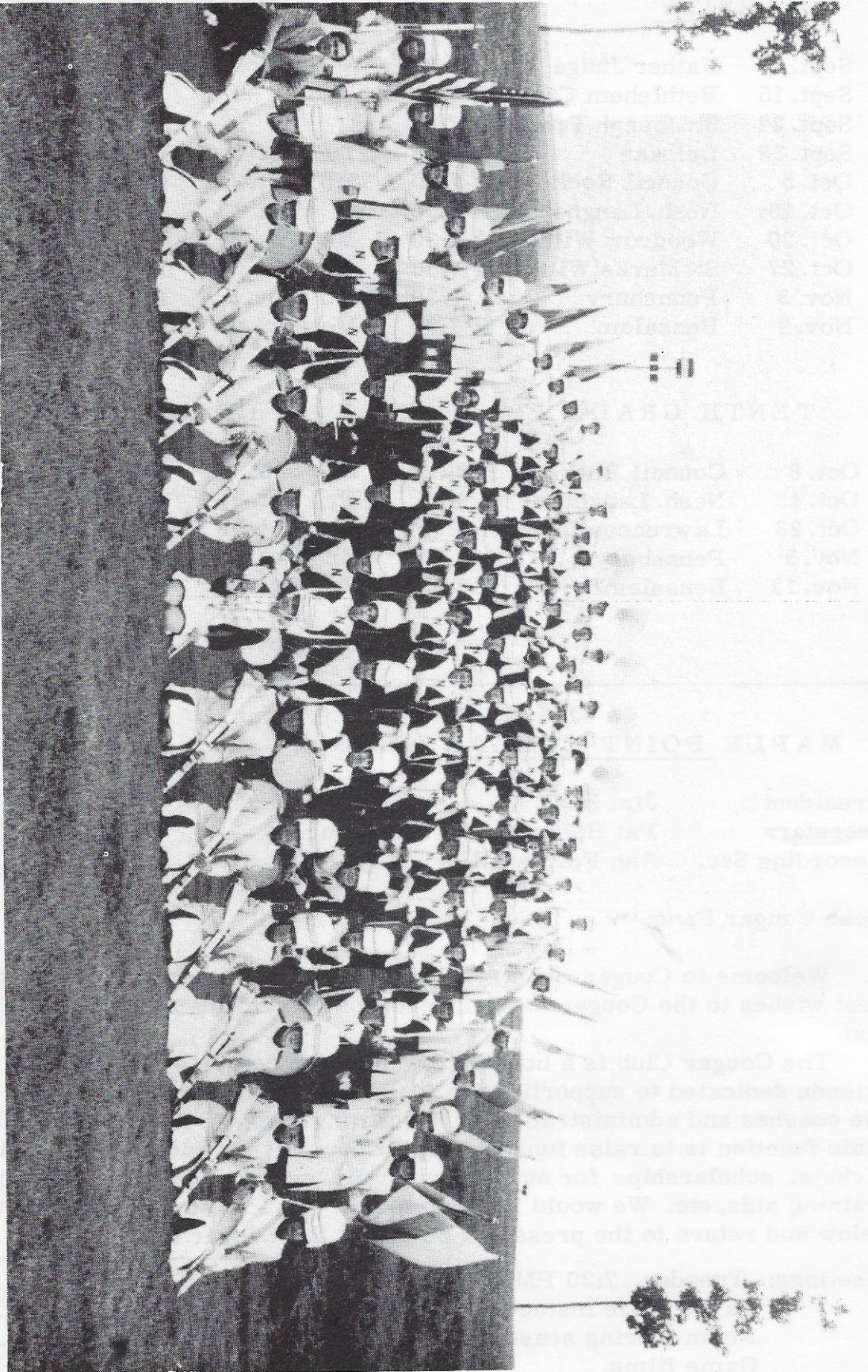
Welcome to Cougar Country. The Maple Point Cougar Club extends its best wishes to the Cougar football team for an exciting and successful season.

Bring on Reading, winner over defending champion State College High School by a 3 to 2 score. Our team was ready, was hot, was "Peaking", this team from Neshaminy Maple Point was going to be State champs.

A light lunch, a little relaxation, some hitting and reporting for the big game. Proudly watching our team warm up and standing in the batter's box while Sharon was warming up, I never had to move -- the ball came in strike after strike -- faster, faster.
