

# Pennridge Surprises Neshaminy

Pennridge's passing combination of juniors Jeff Hollenbach and Dick Roberts clicked for two touchdowns and its defense proved tough in the clutch as the Rams upset Neshaminy 13-0 last night before several thousand fans at Pennridge's South Junior High Field.

Hollenbach connected with Roberts on scoring tosses of eight and 26 yards in the last four minutes of the third quarter and the Pennridge defensive line throttled a fourth-period Neshaminy drive at the six-yard-line to put the game away.

The contest was Pennridge's season opener. Neshaminy, which beat Bishop Egan of Philadelphia last week, is 1-1.

After a scoreless first half, Pennridge's Brad Shelly recovered a Redskin fumble on the Neshaminy 23. A pass interference penalty put the ball on the ten-yard-line and seconds later Hollenbach tossed the eight-yarder to Roberts who was all alone in the end zone. Don Fisher kicked the extra point for the Rams.

Neshaminy, which gained 251 yards on the ground, yet picked up only eight first downs, was unable to move the ball after Pennridge's kickoff and punted from deep in its own territory. Ray Conville returned the punt 13 yards to the Redskin 26 to set up Hollenbach's second touchdown pass to Roberts. The quarterback rolled out and hit his speedy halfback just as he was crossing the goal line. Hollenbach's pass to Roberts in the two-point conversion attempt was incomplete.

Neshaminy, which failed to come up with the big play all night, twice penetrated Pennridge territory as far as the six-yard-line. In the first quarter back-to-back penalties killed the Redskins' drive. A holding violation set them back 15 yards; then when head coach John Swartz ran onto the field to protest the call the officials assessed the Redskins another 15 yards for unsportsmanlike conduct.

With seven minutes left in the fourth quarter Neshaminy had a first down on the Pennridge 6, but the defensive line of Jerry Moyer, Tom Lederach and 254-pound Tom Steinly stopped the Redskins cold.
