PIGSKIN REVIEW NO. 5

A contest which started out like "a house afire" turned into a punting contest (14 in all) between Neshaminy and Dieruff High School in the game played at Neshaminy High Stadium last Friday night. Tommy Thompson took the opening kickoff on his own 10 and ran it back 59 yards - but Dieruff held. Q.B. Jimmy Colbert scored for the Redskins on their next series of downs on an exciting 55 yard scamper which accounted for half of Neshaminy's total yardage gained from scrimmage. Nolte booted the extra point and that ended the scoring for the first half.

In the Third Quarter Dieruff tied the score as Q.B. Studinich completed 4 of 5 passes - the last for 8 yards and a T.D. Final score - 7-7.

A "Hurricane Scalp" will mean a "Redskin Championship" in the Big "6."

As the Redskins of Neshaminy meet the Liberty High School Hurricanes of Bethlehem, Pa. Liberty High, build in 1922, was designed to serve as a war memorial "commemorating the valor of Bethlehem men who went to the front." Hence the name "Liberty High School" was adopted. The school boasts a huge stadium capable of seating 16,588 persons. Besides a modern gymnasium seating 4000 offering excellent facilities for basketball and wrestling, additional land area offers the 3200 students facilities for tennis, soccer, baseball, softball, track, archery and hockey - an all-round athletic program.

Coach Pat Garramone's "11" have a 1-2-1 record thus far this season. Last week the Hurricanes tied William Allen 14-14, and this week Bethlehem will be looking for revenge for the 40-19 trouncing the Redskins gave them in 1964.
