

Cousins Join Bobbys on All-Suburban

The Baker - Thomas duo is back on the Bulletin All-Suburban first team for the second straight year — but the Bobbys aren't the squad's only touchdowns twins.

There's Carmen Frangiosa and Frank Bingham.

They are first cousins. And they led Plymouth - White-marsh High to a 9-1-1 season — including a 22-22 tie with Upper Merion and its Bobbys.

Bingham, 194 pounds, powered for 1,541 yards and 19 touchdowns on 271 carries (7.1 average) — with a high of 316 yards on 13 attempts against Cheltenham — while Carmen (215) was his lead blocker.

Baker to Thomas

Baker completed 148-of-168 aerials for 2,018 yards and 28 TDs (14 interceptions) to edge Central Bucks West's Pat Carey (84-of-145, 1,388 yards, 15 TDs, 6 interceptions) for the quarterback spot.

Thomas (83 catches for 1,253 yards, 21 TDs) had some one size for the other first team end: Chester's 5-9, 150-pound Gibson Ivery (49 catches for 690 yards, 6 TDs). Phoenixville's George Ferko (42-for-847, 5), Methacton's Larry Brunt (46-609, 9) and Archbishop Kennedy's tight end, John Sabia (24-390, 4) had the most votes among the rest.

Neshaminy's Joe Sroba (42-520) and Lansdale Catholic's Chip Zawolski (40-543) were the best backs catching passes. Sroba also rushed 855 yards (6.4 average) and scored 24 TDs. Zawolski 805 yards (5.2 average) and 25 six-pointers. Cotesville's Abel Joe was the area scoring leader (177 points). He carried 167 times for 1,371 yards (8.2 average), scored on a 69-yard TD pass, and returned kicks for touchdowns of 71, 80, 83, 84, 89 yards. O. J. Roberts' 155-pounder Bob Peiffer ground out 1,736 yards (5.4 average) and 23 touchdowns, Pennsbury's Dale Delise 974 and 20.

Nether - Providence's Bill Emper, "a Bill Bradley-type" according to coach Jim McFadden, had nine interceptions to head the defensive backfield. So did Radnor's Larry Nash, who returned his thefts 187 yards while also run-

ning for 752 yards and 11 TDs. Delaware County Back-of-the-Year Ken Bradford, Marple-Newtown, intercepted seven passes in addition to his 1,082-yard rushing total.

Other standout defensive backs were Abington's Steve Dade (11 interceptions), Jenkintown's Kevin Gravatt (10), C. B. West's Dusty Bryan (8), Upper Dublin's Corby Saunders (8), and Woodrow Wilson's Bill Struble (6).

Specialist Herb Orensky,

Sharon Hill, in addition to rushing for 993 yards and 16 TDs, totaled 524 yards in return yardage — 24.6 average on kickoffs. He edged West Chester's Eric Waltz, a dangerous 4.5-for-the-40 speedster who intercepted seven passes and ran for 1,090 yards.

Emerson Haines was the key blocker as West Chester rushed for 3,100 yards. Abington's Tom Stoddard opened the holes as teammate Doug Lee sped through for 1,229

yards. Bill Paolantonio, retiring Conestoga coach, says guard Eric Swanson has more finesse than 1971 Big 33 starter Steve Schindler. Center Ken Miller was a key factor in Don Ford's 922-yard rushing total at Upper Dublin. Penncrest's Perry Hartranft averaged an incredible 21 tackles a game, intercepting seven passes at linebacker. Pennsbury's Ron Dundala (six interceptions) had 93 individual tackles, Abington's Craig

Rickard (five interceptions) 61 individuals and 46 assists. Jim Boaman was the star as Lansdale Catholic allowed only 74.9 yards rushing per game.

The ferocious rush of Mike Sochko (15 sacks) and Larry Seder (19) limited St. Pius X foes to 55-for-182 passing — 54.0 yards per game — while permitting just 48.5 yards rushing. Big Ken Womack, who has 4.9 speed for a 230-pounder, had six sacks when Lansdowne - Aldan won

the Suburban Two championship at Nether-Providence.

Neshaminy's Mark Strawbridge (16 sacks) was Lower Bucks Lineman of the Year over Pennsbury's Tim Miller, who had TDs on an interception and a fumble recovery.

Pennsbury's John Giordano booted six field goals — including a 43-yarder — and 49-of-52 PATs; Pennington's John Rufe had a 47-yard punting average.
