

United Press selects All State teams

PHILADELPHIA (UPI) — Outstanding State College running back Matt Suhey, who led all vote-getters in this year's UPI All-State balloting, has a big decision to make.

College recruiters throughout the country are anxious to land the 5-foot-11, 200-pound senior. "Matt can go anywhere he wants to," said State College Coach Jim Williams. "He's not quite sure where he wants to go yet."

Suhey is joined in the starting backfield on the UPI All-state Scholastic Team, which was chosen by writers and coaches throughout the commonwealth, by quarterback Randy Hochberg.

"I think Randy's definitely underrated," Williams said. "He can run and he can pass even though we don't run the option that much."

"He hasn't made up his mind where he wants to go yet."

Rounding out the first team backfield is running back Mike Guman, of Bethlehem Catholic, considered one of the top players in the country.

Other first team selections include massive offensive tackle Martin Sierocinski, a 6-foot-7, 240-pound senior from Pennsylvania and standout linebacker Bruce Clarke of New Castle. Clarke's teammate, offensive guard Bill Hemming, also made the first team.

Two outstanding linemen on opposite ends of the state made

both the UPI offensive and defensive squads.

Upper St. Clair's Kurt Breckbill, a 6-foot-3, 240-pound senior made the first team as a defensive tackle and the second team as an offensive tackle. Breckbill also has been flooded with offers.

"I'm really not sure yet where I'm going to go," he said. He said he's been in contact with Penn State, Michigan, Pitt, Ohio State, North Carolina State and Purdue, among others. Another heavily-recruited player is big Frank Case of Central Bucks West who shows up on the UPI second team as an offensive and defensive tackle.
