

Quakertown's Prusch Named All-Star Coach

Quakertown football coach Frank Prusch and Pat Picariello of Woodrow Wilson have been named head coaches for the second annual Bucks County Crusade All-Star Football Game to be held June 15, at the Neshaminy High School Stadium.

Prusch, who last fall completed his fifth term at Quakertown, will direct a North team which will be seeking its second consecutive victory in the budding All-Star classic.

The North All-Stars, under the guidance of Central Bucks West's Mike Pettine last year, chalked up a thrilling 28-24 win over a South squad coached by Chuck Kane of Pennsbury.

Both Prusch and Picariello, the latter in his second year as head mentor at Wilson, served as assistant coaches in last year's contest. Each coach has selected one of his own aides to the All-Star coaching staff this time around.

Prusch will have his right-hand man Doug Peiffer from his Quakertown staff along with Bill Juzwiak of William Tennent, and Vernon Young of Central Bucks East. Mike Pettine will serve as trainer for the North All-Stars.

Picariello will be joined on the sidelines by Harry Rinden, Wilson's line coach, Bensalem's Tom Frederick, Bristol's Ron Cardinal and Neshaminy High School trainer Mike Bowman.

Game Chairman Erle Baugher said players for both All-Star squad will be announced later this month.
