

Neshaminy Hands Wilson First Loss

Neshaminy defeated visiting Woodrow Wilson, 17-6, in a Lower Bucks County Section One League game Saturday at Langhorne. The loss was the first in eight games for Wilson while the Redskins (7-1) moved into a first place tie with

Pennsbury.

Andy Koch opened the Redskins scoring with a one-yard plunge to cap a 75-yard march in the second period. Chris Bahr added the conversion kick. In the third quarter, Neshaminy upped its lead to

10-0 on a 29-yard field goal by Bahr.

Later in the same period, Dan Meyers recovered a Wilson fumble on the Ram 22. Six plays later, quarterback John Swartz scored from the two on a keeper. Bahr again convert-

ed.

The lone Wilson TD came in the final quarter on a four-yard run by Joe Quigley.
