

# Grupp, Sroba Power Neshaminy Triumph

Neshaminy High got outstanding performances from quarterback Bob Grupp and halfback Joe Sroba as the Redskins walloped Bensalem, 53-0, in a Lower Bucks County Section One game Friday night at Langhorne.

It was Neshaminy's sixth straight victory after an opening-game loss to Bishop Egan.

Grupp connected on scoring passes of 20 yards to Mark Donahue, 55 and 70 yards to Sroba and 10 yards to Tim O'Brien. Sroba also tallied on a 70-yard punt return as well as on runs of three and 50 yards. The other Redskin TD resulted from Bart Smith's 80-yard interception return.

In the Ches-Mont League Owen J. Roberts nipped Spring-Ford, 22-21, at Royersford as Bob Peiffer tallied on a five-yard run, an eight-yard pass from Eric Tucke and ran for the winning two-point conversion. Roberts' other TD came on Tucker's eight-yard

run. Lance Viola passed for all three Spring-Ford TDs, two of which were caught by Alan Lewis.

In the Bux-Mont League Souderton upset host Quakertown, 17-8, as Scott Brey and Jeff Beans ran for touchdowns. North Penn blanked Perkiomen Valley, 34-0, at Lansdale, with Cary Godshall scoring on a 10-yard run and a 22-yard interception return.

In a Suburban One League game, host Norristown High downed Upper Merion, 34-12, as Rich Fisher ran for two touchdowns and took a pass from Darby Brown for a third TD. The other Eagle six-pointers came on runs by Jeff Butler and Drew Zummo.

In Intercounty League action, Lansdale Catholic remained unbeaten by walloping visiting Daniel Boone, 54-0, as Chip Zawoiski (four runs and a pass from John Wagner) tallied five touchdowns for the second straight game.
