

L. V. Gridders Score High In UPI All-State Voting

HARRISBURG — Three players whose biggest contributions this season were made on defense — Mike Hartenstine of Liberty, Mike Emanuel of Neshaminy and Keith Stoneback of Souderton — were among The Morning Call area players named to the United Press International's first all-state team Monday.

Area players were well represented throughout the UPI listing, with Dieruff tackle Jeff Bleamer and halfbacks Ken Schroy of Quakertown and Jim Fitz-Maurice of Pennsbury earning second-team honors; and split end Bob Handschue of Allen, tackle Matt Szymakowski of Liberty and junior halfback Woody Petchel of Pen Argyl placed on the second team.

Honorable mention went to tackles Larry Schoenberger of Nazareth and Gene Ketchen of Easton; guards Mike Daley of Easton (a linebacker) and Gary Chizmadia of Pennsbury; center Bruce McHale of Neshaminy; and backs Rick Gemmel of Catasauqua, Mitch Lukevics and Bob Ruyak of Liberty and Andy Koch of Neshaminy.

Hartenstine was an outstanding two-way performer for Coach Bob Buifman's Hurricane, which had a 9-1 season, won the Big Seven championship and shared the title in the Big Five. He was a sound block-

er and seldom-used but effective pass catcher as a tight end, but he stood out more from his linebacker spot, with the 6-3, 235-pounder anchoring the Hurricane defense.

Emanuel, a 215-pounder, was also a standout linebacker for Neshaminy, which lost one game and tied one and finished second to Liberty in the Big Seven; while Stoneback played linebacker and offensive tackle for Souderton. On Thanksgiving Day, Stoneback, a 200-pound senior, moved to end for one play and caught a touchdown pass.

Bleamer, a 230-pound senior tackle who played both ways for Dieruff, was a big factor in helping the Huskies to their winningest season ever (7-3) and a share of the Big Five crown; Schroy gained close to 1,400 yards rushing for Quakertown, which tied for the Bux-Mont League title; Handschue caught five TD passes, had punt-return touchdowns of 74, 90 and 89 yards and also intercepted six passes for Allen; Szymakowski teamed with Hartenstine to give

Liberty a solid offensive front and a tough-to-penetrate defense; and Petchel scored 21 touchdowns and rushed for more than 1,500 yards for Pen Argyl.

Allentown College Bows In Opener 69-59

Allentown College of St. Francis de Sales jumped off to an 11-3 lead in the opening minutes last night, but Eastern Baptist charged back from there and ruined Allentown's basketball opener 69-59.

Eastern Baptist tied the score at 16 and then took a lead it never lost again as turnovers and too few rebounds prevented Allentown from threatening seriously. Chris Cashman and Chuck Toth led the scoring for Allentown with 16 and 15 points, respectively, while Paul Thompson paced the winners with 17.

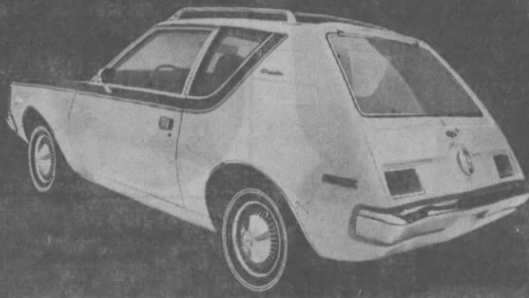
