

Five School Games To Keep Grid Fans Busy This Week-End

Five high school football games will keep the gridiron fans of this vicinity busy over the week-end. Four of the games will be played under the lights with an afternoon game being played to-day.

The Bristol fans will be able to see the Warriors in action tonight as the Bristol boys meet Hatboro High on the local field at 8.30 o'clock. It will be the season's opener for both teams.

Morrisville, fresh from an inaugural triumph over Upper Moreland, plays its second game under the lights at Jenkintown, meeting Coach Walt Blair's eleven. This tilt starts at eight o'clock.

The Bensalem Owls will be seeking their first triumph as they meet Central Bucks (Doylestown) on the latter's field. This is also a night fracas. Bensalem lost to Sellersville-Perkasie, 15-12, last Saturday.

This afternoon, Delhaas High will break into big time football by meeting Council Rock on the Newtown field. Council Rock is a member of the Lower Bucks League. Neither team has played this season.

Tomorrow night, Neshaminy meets Pennsbury High on the Morrisville high school field at eight o'clock. Neshaminy lost to Ambler and Pennsbury bowed to Souder-ton in their openers last week. This will be the first scheduled Lower Bucks County circuit clash.
