

Neshaminy Extends Streak to 18, Beats Royersford, 13-7

For Royersford the past Saturday, defeat went under the name of Mike Ahlum.

It was Ahlum, Neshaminy end, who took two payoff passes to lead the visitors to their 18th straight victory, a 13-7 win over the Eagles who were unable to score until the final period.

Seven plays after the opening kickoff, Jack Cummings flipped a 33-yard aerial to Ahlum who went over from the five. Jack Moronese's run for the extra point was short.

The tally was set up by linebacks by Moronese and a pass from Joe Neilson to Max Kauffman.

The second period was filled with fumbles as neither club could get anywhere. Royersford's pass defense forced Neshaminy to kick, and following the boot, runs by Hal Johnston and Miller carried to the midfield stripe where the drive was stopped cold. Jansen Fray kicked to the visitor's 19, and two plays later the 'Ford forward wall recovered Neilson's bobble, but a play later both Ralph Biebler and Carl had a hand in a fumble that was recovered by Neshaminy's Moyer.

THE EAGLES were stalled after the second half kickoff, then the Indians put together a 68-yard drive that netted their final TD. Following runs by Pete Latham, Kauffman, Moronese and Neilson, Neshaminy moved down to the Eagles 43. On fourth down, Kauffman hit Ed Rothenbach for a first down on the 29 and Cummings carried to the 13.

Two plays later, Kauffman pitched to Ahlum for the score. Moronese kicked the extra point.

In the closing minutes of the third quarter, Fray was forced to kick from his own 20. Henry Wojton's hard tackling of Neilson caused the safety man to fumble and Bill Rogers recovered for the Eagles on the Indian's 49. Miller picked up four off left tackle and Carl followed up with a 16-yard gallop to the 29.

The Eagle's only marker came two plays into the final period. Bieber connected with Jim Bauer on the Indian's eight and Bauer went over for the score. Carl ran for the extra point.
