Defensive back Joe DeBelle picked off an errant Bishop Kenrick pass and returned it 38 yards for a touchdown, then Greg Cowhey's conversion gave Cardinal Dougherty (4-1, 5-2) a 7-6 win in Northern Division Catholic League action last night.

Four scoring runs by James McDevitt lifted host Great Valley (5-1, 6-1 and No. 8 in The Inquirer ratings) past Downingtown, 26-20, in the Ches-Mont League. McDevitt's 18-yard TD run with 4:29 left in the game capped a seven-play 84-yard drive. The senior running back finished with 147 yards on 24 carries.

Kevin Ward scored four touchdowns and passed to Dave Parsons for another as Central Bucks West (No.1 in The Inquirer ratings) plastered visiting Wissahickon, 42-0. Ward totaled 119 yards on 10 carries as the Bux-Mont League co-leaders (5-0, 7-0) rushed for 320 yards.

Lansdale Catholic moved into sole possession of first place in the Intercounty League with a 17-7 victory over visiting Holy Name. Tom Femularo scored twice for the Crusaders (5-0-1).

In non-league action, Ken Saunders and Bob Homa rushed for touchdowns as host Salesianum (6-1) knocked off Archbishop Ryan, 12-0, and Brian O'Rourke's two scoring runs paced Neshaminy Langhorne (2-0, 3-2) past Trenton Central, 34-14.
