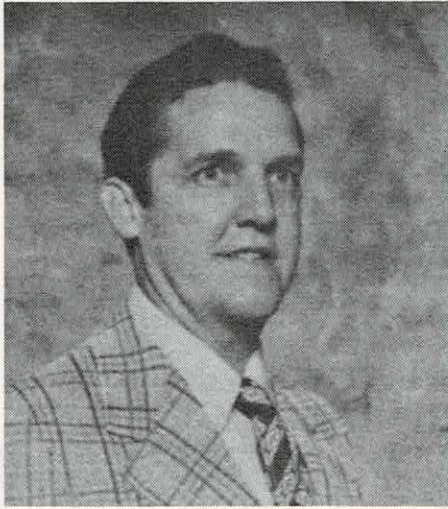

Only time will tell if the Cougars were able to put it all together. Good luck to Coach Chaump, his assistants, and all of the players. This could be the year!

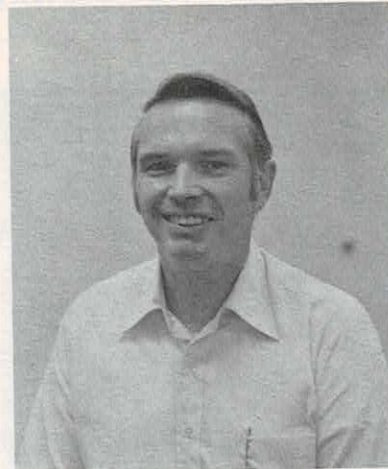
