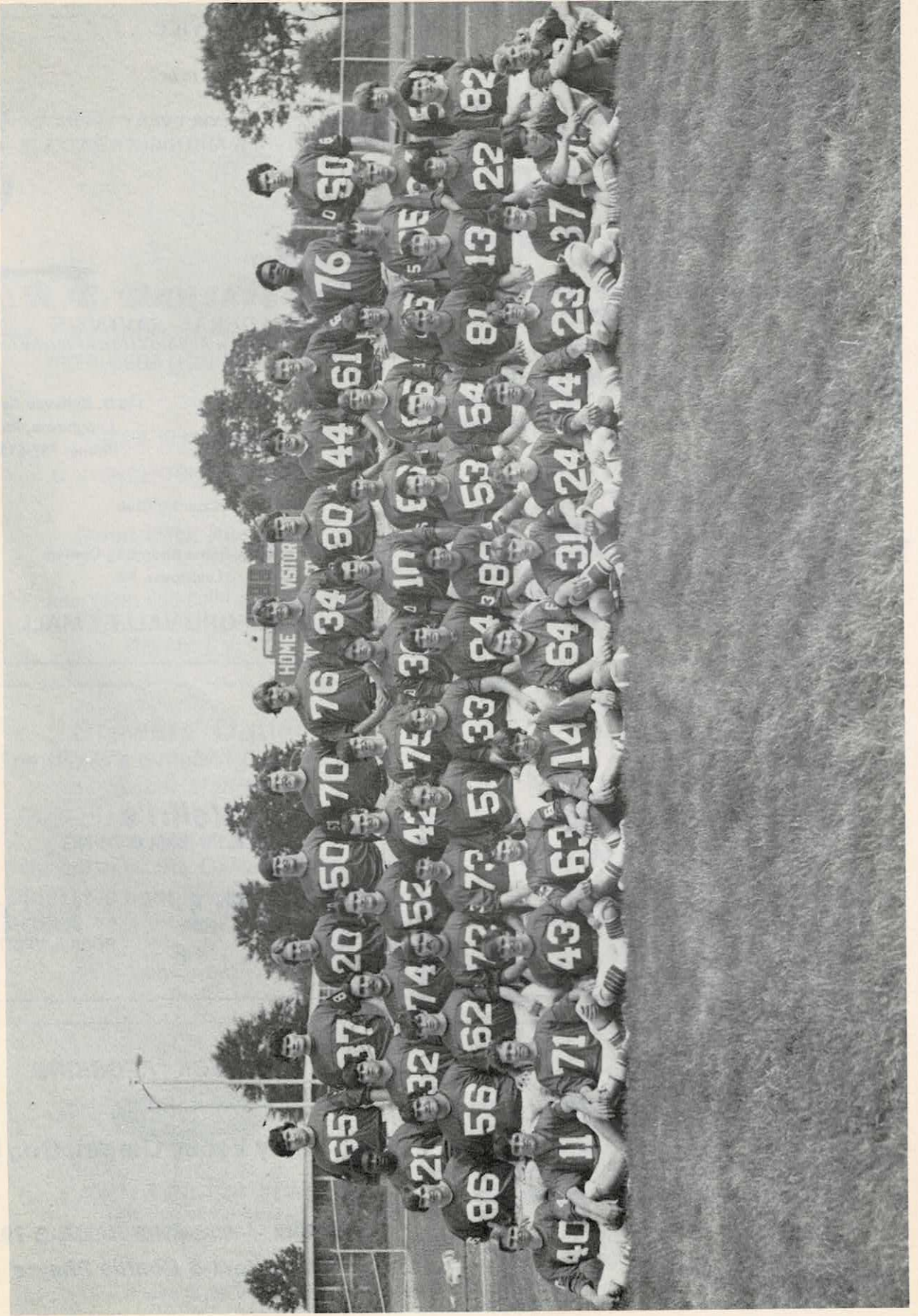

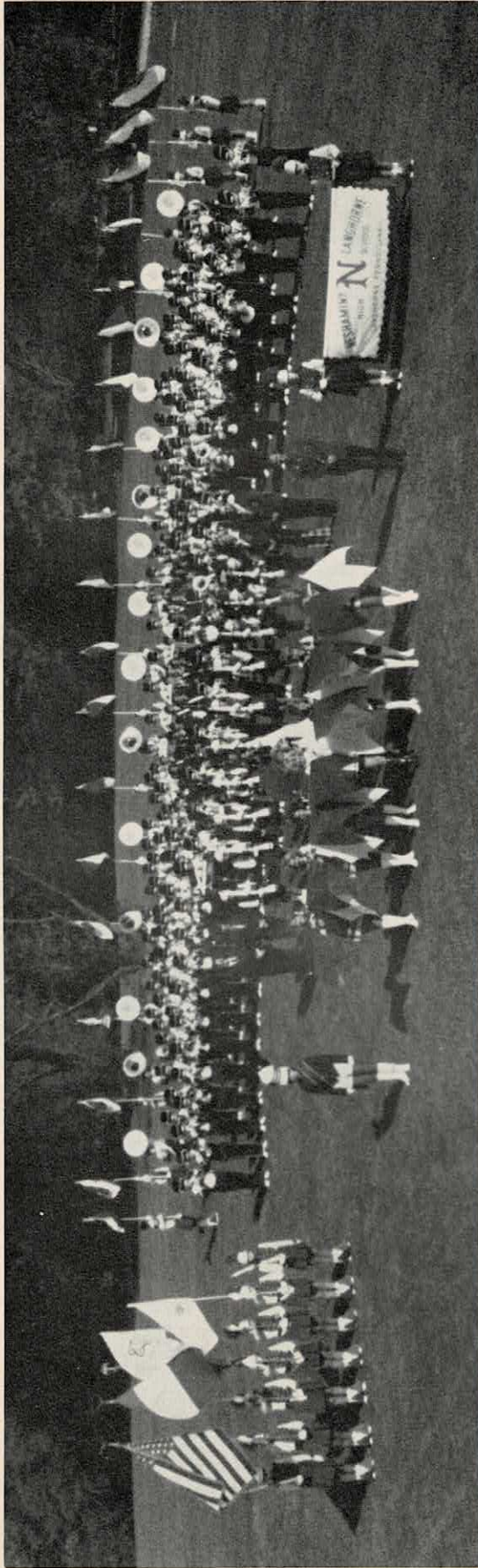

Neshaminy Langhorne Marching Band



The Neshaminy Langhorne High School Marching Band has 250 members and is one of the many instrumental music organizations at the high school. Other than the Marching Band, Neshaminy Langhorne High School offers its instrumental music students: Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Concert Jazz Ensemble, String Orchestra, Competition Color Guard, and Swing Flag Unit. These performing organizations are responsible for over 60 performances each year in the school, community, and throughout the United States. They have received awards for their performances in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and Delaware and have performed at such events as the Mardi Gras parades in Louisiana and several televised National Basketball League games at the Spectrum in Philadelphia. Last year, the Marching Band received special invitations to perform at the Festival of Five Flags in Florida and the Cotton Bowl Parade in Texas.

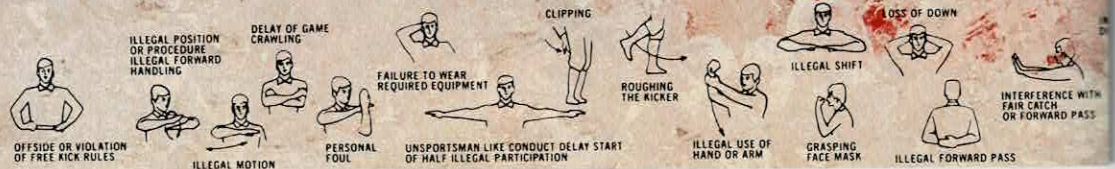
In 1976, the band received the distinct honor of representing Bucks County and Pennsylvania in the week long activities for St. Patrick's Day in Ireland. As musical ambassadors, the band was ceremoniously presented the county and federal bicentennial flags which we were to carry during our performances in Ireland. In addition, we presented personal letters from Governor Shapp and the famous limited edition Bucks County Bicentennial Tile to designated Irish government officials.

While in Ireland, our tradition of excellence in musical sound and precision marching was continued when the Marching Band won first place honors in all three competition categories (Best Band Front, Best High School Band, and Best Overall Performing Organization) during the International Competition in Limerick, Ireland. This feat was repeated in Dublin, Ireland, where we competed with over 50 bands from all over the world. It is believed that this is the first time one band has been able to win all three categories in both competitions and for this honor, the band received nationwide coverage in the international news media. As a further result of this accomplishment, the band was invited to perform at the Lord Mayor's Ball, where many foreign dignitaries were in attendance.

In addition, state-wide honors for last year included: the Color Guard receiving a Citation from the Pennsylvania House of Representatives for its outstanding competitive performances; the Concert Jazz Band winning the National Judges All Chapter Championship held in Wildwood, New Jersey, while competing against schools representing a tri-state area; and the Marching Band appearing on national television news programs four times--two times as features of the band itself.

JIM WEBER – *Offensive Line*

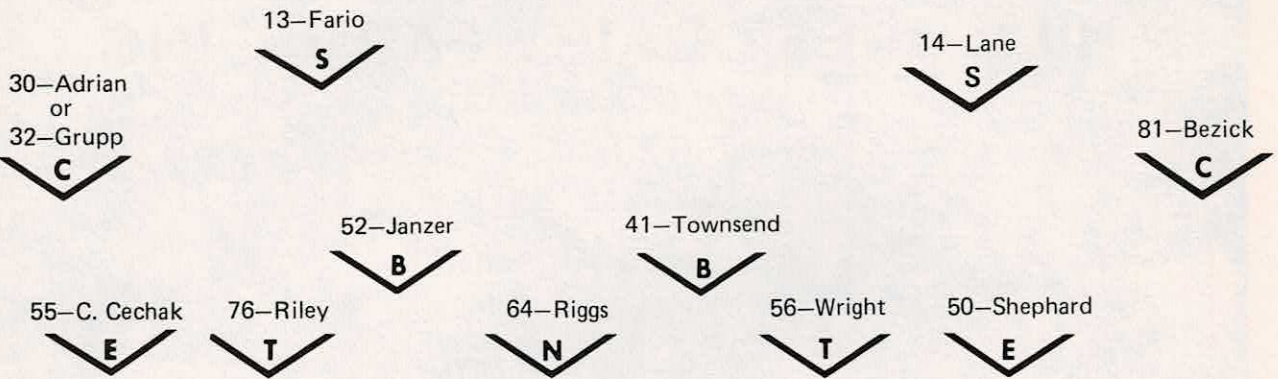

FRED HARTSHORN – *Defensive Line*

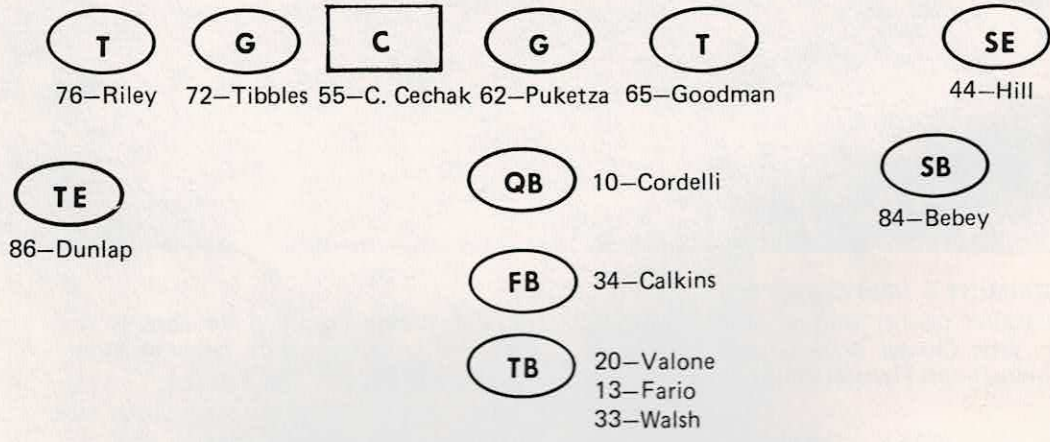
