



#### BEACON LODGE CAMP FOR THE BLIND

Beacon Lodge is situated on State Route 103, two miles southwest of Newton Hamilton, Pa., along the beautiful Juniata River. The hills and mountains of Central Pennsylvania surround the camp, making it a secluded place for those that require rest, and rugged enough for those who enjoy rugged activity.

The camp occupies a 567 acre estate through which flows a babbling brook. The Main Lodge where the women campers are housed, is a twenty-eight room structure with comfortable sleeping quarters for forty persons. The dining hall, with seating accommodations for 150, and the large modern kitchen are also located in the Main Lodge. The large living room with a huge fireplace, a piano, and an electric organ is a favorite spot for adult campers. The room has a balcony with a braille library and talking books. Close by is Tarentum Hall with a snack bar and a second floor with facilities for fifteen persons. Female campers and staff are housed here. 14B Dormitory is a one floor cement block structure with accommodations for 48 male campers and staff. 14D Dormitory has accommodations for four married couples. The Infirmary consists of nurses quarters, dispensary, and rooms for patients assigned, and married couples.

In Childrens Village there are twelve cement block cabins well ventilated and screened with complete bathroom facilities in each cabin and individual storage cabinets for personal items. Each cabin will accommodate 6 children and their counselors. A larger building provides kitchen and dining room facilities. It is also a food storage building, and living quarters with an office for the unit director. The summer of 1975, a brand new air conditioned Infirmary with nurses quarters and a boys' and girls' ward was dedicated to the late Paul Mahady, a Pennsylvania State Senator and a Past International Director of Lions.

This year a new activities building will be opened in the village. A physician in nearby Mount Union is available at the camp and the modern Huntingdon and Lewistown Hospitals are also available in time of need.

All guests are free to do the things they enjoy most. Beacon Lodge attempts to satisfy two types of campers. Those who want to rest and relax among old friends and to make new ones. Those who prefer a more active type ofvacation may select a program of varied activities. There is a choice of motor boating, rowing, hiking, shuffleboard, roller skating, bowling, campfire programs, picnics, overnight hikes, mountain climbing, bus rides, baseball (with a beeping ball), wrestling, field events, bike riding, shopping tours, arts & crafts, dancing, and swimming. You must visit the camp to truly appreciate it. The 36 members of the Board of Directors is very proud that they have been able to keep the weekly fee to \$65.00. The actual cost is \$99.80 per week. Many Lions Districts pick up the tab for utilities and maintenance, thus enabling the camp to operate at such a low fee.

Keeping Pitt football on top is no problem when you have someone like head coach Jackie Sherrill around. The Panther Headman is young and experienced — you can't ask for a better blend from a coach who must relate to more than one hundred different college football players simultaneously.

Although Sherrill's beginning his first season as the Panther leader this year, he's been part of the Panther success story for some time now.

Sherrill, 33, served as Assistant Head Coach and Defensive Coordinator at Pitt from 1973-75, before accepting the head coaching position at Washington State following Pitt's 33-19 win over Kansas in the

Sherrill sharpened the talents of many good football players at Washington State. His undermanned Cougars were highly feared in the tough Pacific Eight Conference, and Jackie Sherrill proved he was

already one of the nation's finest collegiate head coaches.

When the coaching vacancy opened at the University of Pittsburgh, there was no mystery about the man most wanted by everyone concerned with Pitt football. The University administration, Panther fans and — most importantly — Pitt's football players wanted Jackie Sherrill to return to the Panther's den.

Sherrill exhibited this energy and drive long before he wanted to become a head coach. He was an honorable mention All-America and All-State at Biloxi (Miss.) High School. He then enrolled at Alabama and played seven different positions.

The three-year letterman for Bear Bryant's Crimson Tide was a member of the 1964 and 1965 national championship teams. He also played in the 1964 and 1965 Sugar Bowl games and the 1966 Orange Bowl game.

Following graduation, he coached at Alabama for a year before moving to Arkansas in 1967. He joined the staff at Iowa State in 1968 before joining the Pitt family in 1973.

He has coached on five bowl teams.



#### DON TOLLEFSON Sports Director WPVI/TV

Although he is only 25, Don Tollefson's journalistic experience belies his youthful age. Don entered Stanford University when he was 17 and he quickly became a part-time correspondent for both the Associated Press and the San Francisco Chronicle. As a sophomore in college — Don became sports editor of The Stanford Daily, and during the next year and a half — he moved ahead rapidly — from entertainment editor — to news editor — and finally, to editor-in-chief as a 19 year old junior. While still an undergraduate, Don left Stanford to become a full-time correspondent for the Associated Press in 1974. His first major assignment was covering the Patty Hearst kidnapping. For 6 months, Don lived outside the Hearst mansion in Hillsborough, California — sending dispatches around the world for the AP. In the fall of 1974, Don became the youngest network football announcer ever, when he joined ABC Sports as an announcer for college football. Don came to ACTION NEWS in 1975 and served as a general



assignment reporter and suburban bureau chief — before becoming sports director in 1976. Don is single, he's a fanatic tennis player and jogger and as his record proves - he's a young man on the move.

#### NORTH ALL-STAR HISTORY

It's not whether you win or lose...

It doesn't mean they don't take the game seriously. They work hard at it in both camps, North and South, for the Bucks County All-Star football game. They work very hard. And they do it in hot, muggy June weather with full equipment after the first couple days of practice.

Someone joked to North coach Walt Snyder last year during the pre-game practice about his small boy running around the field among the older boys.

The boy was chasing down practice punts, sometimes throwing them back to the kicker.

"He going to return punts for you next week?" the person asked Snyder.

"Not this time," said Snyder without breaking a smile. "But someday. He's going to work at it."

He was dead serious. There's nothing funny about the game of football in Snyder's eyes. The game can be fun — for sure. But only when it is played right.

Snyder's hard intent paid off for the North team last year.

Partly through Snyder's discipline, the North beat the South 14-0, taking its third straight victory and a 4-2 advantage in the series since it came under the sponsorship of the Bucks County Lions.

A stingly defense was the key to the North's success as it held the South to 95 yards rushing and 52 passing.

The North on the other hand rolled up 198 yards on the ground and 114 in the air. Council Rock quarterback Pete Alliegro accounted for most of the ariel advancements while Archbishop Wood's Rick Wiltrout accumulated 73 yards rushing.

Quakertown's Jeff Rodenberger scored both touchdowns, both times going in from the 2 as the North controlled the ball.

The more defensively attuned North team forced the South to punt six times while it only punted three times.

Even though it was another victory for the North, it was unlike the two previous wins — romps in the literal sense with 35-12 and 45-6 victories.

But it isn't whether you win or lose nor how much you can score.

They'll tell you in both camps that the thing that means most to them is just the playing. The chance to get back on the scholastic gridiron just one more time with high school rivals and friends means a lot to these youngsters. And just because they are now only young men, doesn't mean they don't understand all the good that comes from such a charity benefit.

Wayne Helman, coach of the Bux-Mont League co-champion Pennridge, heads up this year's All-Star North squad. His short tenure shouldn't be any different than Snyder's.

Helman has been coaching football and track since the mid 1950's and his presence demands respect. For Helman, the game of football isn't funny, either. It is important to him that the game be fun. Especially in this All-Star game. There is nothing to be lost. No championships to be won.

At stake here is the sight and hearing of the county's disabled.

But that's cause in itself.

You can only win in this game.

#### **SOUTH ALL-STAR HISTORY**

Some things never seem to change. The Philadelphia Eagles can't win, Penn State gets overlooked in the polls and the North can't lose a Bucks County Lions All-Star Game.

Last year was no exception. The North did it again, winning for the third year in a row, by taking a 14-0 decision at Pennridge High School in Perkasie.

It was the North's fourth win in six games in a series which dates back to sponsorship from the Bucks County Cancer Society. This also marked the first shutout in the half-dozen games.

As usual, players from the "lower" end of the county appeared to play a key role in the North victory.

#### Defense shines

Ends Steve Lentz of William Tennent and Rich Bone of Council Rock helped hold the South, guided by Woodrow Wilson coach Ed Neumann, to just 77 yards on the ground. They were assisted by Council Rock's Rich Welch, William Tennent linebacker Ted Kitson and Archbishop Wood middle guard Harry Brooks.

The game was played in a driving rain before 5,000 onlookers at Lloyd "Pappy" Yoder Field. Weather may have been a factor in the outcome since South quarterbacks Roy Remsburg of Woodrow Wilson and Neshaminy Maple Point's Tom Meier were known for their passing prowess.

The North scored the only touchdown it needed in the second quarter when Quakertown's Jeff Rodenberger capped off an 81-yard drive with a one-yard run. A South fumble resulted in an insurance touchdown for the North in the third quarter, with Rodenberger completing a 16-yard march with a two-yard plunge.

And so the controversy continues. Is the North better than the South? It's hard to argue with statistics.

#### Publicity

"In earlier years, I think the game became a showcase for the North," said Neumann. "The South always seemed to get more attention in the Philadelphia newspapers and this game gave the North a chance to show how good it was.

"I don't think there's any difference in talent," he added. "I haven't really given any thought to equity."

Some people would like to see either Wood, Tennent or Council Rock returned to the South.

"I don't know about that," said Neumann. "I do know that the South is getting sick of losing. We played on this quite a bit last year. I'm sure it's why they took the game very seriously."

After lopsided scores the two previous years (including a 36-12 North victory in '75), the South came out and made it close for a change.

#### Over the top

"We were in it until the fourth quarter," said Neumann. "The kids didn't take it like it was a league game until the game started. It was nice that they could make it close and this year it might help put things over the top."

This year's game is being played at Bensalem Stadium, home of last year's Lower Bucks County League champion Owls. Neumann believes the home crowd and field will give the South an extra incentive.

"Definitely, it will be a factor. You feel more comfortable playing on a field you're familiar with. Last year was the first time I or most of the kids had ever been on that field. Playing at Bensalem, which has a lot of kids on the team, has to be an advantage."

# LEADER DOGS FOR THE BLIND ROCHESTER, MICHIGAN

Exit # 29 of

Penn. Turnpike

and U.S. Route 13

Leader Dogs for the Blind was founded in 1939 by a group of Michigan Lions; to train dogs to lead blind persons and provide facilities and means whereby blind persons may obtain Leaders. The non-profit organization is served by a national board of 30 trustees.

People with less than usual vision, over 16 years of age, in good health, emotionally stable and of good moral character may be eligible for Leader Dog training. The Students live under constant supervision of competent instructors during a four week training period. An instructor and housemother are on duty at all times. Training is conceived as a re-education emotionally and physically to a new way of effective living.

After a period of "getting acquainted" with his Leader Dog, the student is taken to the small, quiet town of Rochester where actual pedestrian training is begun. In progressive stages adjustment to more hazardous traffic conditions is accomplished through training on busy streets, in the heavy traffic and hurrying crowds of Birmingham and Royal Oak, Michigan.

At the end of four weeks training with a Leader Dog, the hesitant blind student is changed to an erect confident person who has challenged and conquered one of life's severest handicaps.

A Leader Dog enjoys its superiority. It is not just a dog, it is a Leader Dog, capable of making decisions that protect the safety of the owner. The fledgling dog must be from one to two years old, in good condition and willing to accept responsibility. Dogs must be positively friendly even to strangers. German Shepherds, Labradors and Golden Retrievers are commonly trained as Leaders. All dogs are contributed. Leader Dogs know the rules of safety. Stop—Look—Listen—then cross the street briskly. Leaders are taught to respect traffic, vehicular and pedestrian, and will respond to the given command only when the way is clear. Most dog owners say the dog is a family pet and romps with the children but the instant they put on the harness the dog is all business.

If you know anyone who could use a Leader Dog, contact your local Lions Club. The training as a student, food, lodging, and the Leader Dog are all at no cost to a qualified blind person. Usually, transportation to the school and back is paid for by the Lions Club.



#### THE BUCKS COUNTY BLIND AND REHABILITATION CENTER

Since the Association has moved into their new facilities on Freedom Drive off of Route 413 in in Newtown, a new concept of rehabilitating blind people has taken place. When the Association was housed in the separate facilities at Bristol and Doylestown, the blind people were employed by the Association making the traditional brooms, caning chairs, and making door mats. Now the goal is to train as many people as possible to go into industry as confident, competent workers experienced in a variety of assembly and sub-assembly components. In the seven years since the move into Newtown, 150 people have been trained and now hold jobs on their own. For the individuals not able to adjust to an alien environment the Association still maintains a certain amount of the traditional jobs. The Association has at the present time over 100 blind and handicapped employed at the Newtown facility. The Neville Greenery, where seedlings and plants are grown, tended to, and sold by blind and handicapped personnel, is an innovation and a first in the field of working with the blind. George Carver, a Lions International Counsellor, is the reigning President of the Board of Trustees. Lion Carver has been preceded in that office by three prominent Bucks Countians; John T. Welsh, Daniel Tomlinson, and Judge Isaac Garb. The Executive Director is Matt Treihart.

Funds are obtained by a mail solicitation (Foote books) and contributions from Lions' Clubs, other organizations and individuals. A word of warning no door to door or phone solicitations are made by The Bucks County Blind and Rehabilitation Center. If you receive such a solicitation, be assured it is not the Bucks County Blind Association.

When you do receive your book in the mail, be generous to this organization that services all the handicapped.



#### THE PA. LIONS SIGHT CONSERVATION AND EYE RESEARCH FOUNDATION

- 1. Blindness is one of our major public health problems—every hour in every day, five more people face a lifetime of darkness. Most of the blindness is due to diseases, causes of which are unknown, or to diseases where causes are known but for which no effective treatment is available. Several years ago we might have been content to care for these blind once they reached that stage. This is not good enough today. We must seek the causes of blindness and thus prevent it before it occurs.
- 2. Let us look at what is happening right here in the United States—not in Africa or one of the undeveloped countries of the world. The blind population is increasing at a rate nearly twice that of the general population. In a twenty year period (1940-1960) the blind population increased 67%, while the general pop. increased by 36%. Not only is the trend continuing, but we have reason to believe it is increasing.
- 3. Obviously, the answer to blindness is not rehabilitation, and it is not merely providing assistance for the ever increasing blind population at an ever increasing cost—both in human tragedy and financial resources. The only reasonable answer is a vastly accelerated and intensified program of eye research. It is clear that we must put more planning, more effort, and more money into research leading to the causes of blindness. It is far better to prevent people from becoming blind and every intelligent person should do so by supporting The Pa. Lions Sight Conservation and Eye Research Foundation.
- 4. Has anything ever been accomplished medically through research? Remember the year 1963 and the Salk vaccine and the almost complete eradication of Polio? In the early 1920's an entire floor and a half of the Philadelphia General Hospital was devoted to people with Diptheria. As they died or were sent home blind, deaf, or mentally retarded new patients came in to take their places. Many of today's young doctors have never seen a patient with Diptheria. Small Pox has been a scourge of mankind for centuries. Except for a few remote places in the world which will soon be attended to, Small Pox is a thing of the past.
- 5. The expenditure of money to determine the causes of blindness should be considered an investment that will pay priceless dividends to all Americans. Whether we examine the problem in terms of its cost in dollars, or from the human aspect of personal tragedy and the increasing threat to ourselves, one stark fact is absolutely clear: For a growing number of Americans, the only hope of preventing or curing blindness is through research. The work of your Eye Research Foundation is aimed directly at the root of the problem. It looks to causes. It seeks answers.

In 1948 we started with 20 charter members. In 1963 we had dropped to 16, 1973 we had 30 strong members. Today we have 26. During our 30 years we have participated in practically every type of fund raising, Selling, Dances, Auto Show, White Cane, 50/50s, entertainment (Minstrel & Variety Shows). We have collected and spent on community projects approximately \$50,000.00. In spite of the tremendous growth of our Township we have only increased our membership by about one third. Better known as the Delaware Valley Eye Bank this dedicated group of men are all Lions. The Eye Bank was founded in 1957 and has an admirable record of accomplishment. Over 6,000 people have regained their sight as a result of corneal transplants. Examining their newsletter reveals the fact that in the last few years one person a day has had a successful transplant. It must be made clear that not the whole eye is transplanted. The clear portion of the eye that covers the lens called the cornea is the part used. In recent years some operations on accident victims have used the scolera or white portion of the eye. Some infants are born with defective fluid (called vitreous humour) which instead of being perfectly clear is milky and obstructs vision. This fluid can be drained and replaced with the clear fluid from donated eyes. This vitreous humour can be stored for a limited time in much the same manner as blood plasma.

The Eye Bank serves Southeastern Pa., all of Delaware and New Jersey. The State Police of all three states and many Local Police transport donated eyes. Our Eye Bank is a charter member of the Eye Bank Association of America and the International Eye Bank. An important phase of the service is the Eye Ball Network of Ham Operators which twice daily broadcasts the need or availability of eyes to all Eye Banks. This network is responsible for the transfer of approximately 7,000 eyes annually.

The eye bank is on call 24 hours, seven daysa week. Our local office is in the Wills Eye Hospital. The phone number is LOcust 9-3937 or LO-9-EYES. If you want any information, please call. The demand for eyes is greater than the supply. If more eyes were available, 40% of the blind in the U.S. could have their sight restored. You ask, "Are my eyes of any use to you? I have cataracts. I wear glasses. I am afflicted with an eye disease." The answer is yes, your eyes are of value regardless of your age or the condition of your sight. Only healthy tissue is used in a transplant. Eyes with defects are used for research or for medical students to practice operations. (Who would go for eye surgery to a man that had never operated on an eye?) The fact is a donated unhealthy eye may prevent more human suffering through research than one that can be used in a transplant.
