

LOWER BUCKS LEAGUE TO HAVE TWO SECTIONS

Be in One Section**

The Lower Bucks County Scholastic Basketball League will be divided into two sections, according to the plans as set forth at a meeting of the representatives of the schools held Monday night in the Bristol High School with President John Hoffman, of Morrisville, presiding.

The upper section will be composed of Buckingham, Southampton and Langhorne while Bristol, Fallsington, Bensalem and Morrisville will make up the lower section of the circuit.

The leagues will have both varsity and junior varsity competition with trophies being awarded to the winners and runner-ups of both sections.

The representatives also decided to endeavor to enlist all schools in the forthcoming baseball season and President Hoffman suggested that the various coaches get in touch with all nearby schools to form a ten-team league, divided into two sections.
