

LANGHORNE WILL MEET BENSALEM AT LANGHORNE

LANGHORNE, Nov. 26 — Coach "Mike" DeRisi and his Redskins will attempt to give Langhorne High its second Lower Bucks County championship tomorrow morning when it meets Bensalem High on Playwicky field. Kickoff is scheduled for ten o'clock.

In addition to the Lower Bucks County gonfalon, the Langhorne team will receive the American Legion trophy if it defeats Bensalem. Langhorne has beaten Bensalem twice since the trophy was put up by the Soby Post and needs another win to keep the trophy permanently.

There is no reason why Langhorne should not triumph over the Cornwells lads who won their first game of the season last Wednesday by beating Lower Moreland. Bensalem has lost six games and tied another. Langhorne has a record of six wins, two defeats, and a tie. It has won over both Morrisville and Bristol while both these schools beat Bensalem.

However, Bensalem made the head-lines last season when they beat Langhorne to spoil DeRisi's fine season in his first year of coaching at the Langhorne-Middletown institution.
