

Bristol Triumphs In Lower Bucks

Bristol High School scored in the third period to gain a 7-0 victory over Morrisville High in a Lower Bucks County League football game at Bristol yesterday. It was the 11th victory for the winners in the 17 years' series. In another league test, Langhorne High School beat Bensalem, 12-2, on the latter's field.

Bristol's winning touchdown came when Ed Capriotti recovered a blocked kick on Morrisville's 10-yard line, and Joe McDevitt passed to Dom Oriolo in the end zone.
