

BRISTOL HIGH ELEVEN EASILY DEFEATS LANGHORNE HIGH TEAM BEFORE LARGE CROWD, 34 TO 0

LANGHORNE, Oct. 29 — The power-packed Bristol High School team drubbed the Langhorne-Middletown High School eleven, 34-0, before a large crowd on Playwickie field, here Saturday afternoon.

The light Langhorne team could do little with the Bunnies who seemed to gain ground at will, pushing over five touchdowns and scoring four extra points, all via line plays.

During the first three quarters of the tilt, Bristol toyed with the Redskins and on their line crashes were averaging over five yards at a clip. The Bunnies did not use many of their deceptive plays as they were unnecessary against the weak Langhorne team.

Only in the final period did the Redskins show any offensive power. In this session they opened with their fine aerial passes and reached as far as the Bristol 29 yard line before the Bunnies braced and held the Langhorne team for downs, the latter missing by inches.

"Johnny" Centonze scored a pair of the Bristol touchdowns and also added a duo of extra points. Both he and Lelinski tore the Langhorne line to shreds by their constant line-bucking. After Centonze and Lelinski were through, "Eddie" Capriotti and Sal Accardi took up the burden and continued the attack.

As this was the first tilt this season that the Bristol team rolled up a big majority of points, Coach Harold Stackhouse used 25 players in the tilt and during most of the game kept his regular linemen on the bench in preparation for the Burlington game next week.

It was evident from the start of the contest that Bristol's weight would overpower the Langhorne boys. Foltz kicked off to Fallon who was dropped on his 15. Lukens tried the line without success. Schneider could not get going on an end run and lost four yards. Schneider tried the line and was stopped. He then kicked to Capriotti, who caught the ball on the 40 and got away to be stopped on the eight yard line. But Bristol was penalized 15 yards from the 25 and the ball brought back to the 40. Lelinski gained a first down on the first play but Keller recovered a fumble on the next play and the Redskins had the ball on their 24. Lukens and Schneider failed to gain, so Schneider kicked to Capriotti, who was spilled on the Langhorne 40. Centonze found an opening at tackle and didn't stop running until he reached the 22. Lelinski hit tackle for four yards and then followed by making a first down on the 12. Centonze gained five yards on an end run and Capriotti made it first down on the 3. Centonze was stopped on the goal line but Lelinski ploughed over for the touchdown. Centonze cracked the right side of the Langhorne line for the extra point, making it 7-0.

Lukens returned Foltz's kick-off to the five yard line where he was spilled by McClintic. Mari broke through to drop Schneider for a 3-yard loss. Mari and Lelinski broke through to block Schneider's kick. It rolled beyond the goal line where Centonze fell on it for a touchdown. Capriotti hit the line for the extra point, the scoring then being 14-0.

Righter caught the next kickoff and wastackled by Lou Mari on the

before the half was over with Centonze doing the ball-carrying.

Trailing 27-0, the Langhorne team had plenty of pep at the start of the second half. Mari kicked to Fallon who went to his 28. Lukens gained five yards and Schneider three. Schneider threw a pass to Righter who had the pigskin but dropped it. Schneider kicked to Capriotti who was downed on his 28. Lelinski skirted end for nine yards and Centonze followed it with another end run for a first down on Langhorne's 41. After Capriotti gained 15 yards on another end sweep, Bristol was penalized back to its 39. Lelinski gained four yards and Capriotti made it a first on the 50. Accardi followed this with a first down on the 34. Lelinski gained eight yards on an end run and Centonze made it first down on the Langhorne 20. Accardi nicked the line for eight yards and Caucci on an end run lost 2. Capriotti went off tackle for a first down on the 10. Lelinski again hit the line for 9 yards and Accardi went the other yard for a touchdown. Centonze hit the line for the extra point, the score being 34-0.

At the start of the final canto, Lelinski on two plays netted 15 yards to make a first down on the Langhorne 30. Langhorne had received the kick but failed to gain so kicked to the Bristol 20 where Capriotti returned it 20 yards. But that was as far as Bristol got as Langhorne braced and held for down. Langhorne's best offensive playing followed as Beswick gained four yards and after two other line plays failed, Langhorne kicked and it was fumbled on the 46, with the Redskins recovering. A pass, Righter to Hibbert gained 15 yards and Langhorne's second first down. After Beswick was thrown for a small loss, a pass failed. Righter then completed short pass to Hibbert and Fizzano but fell short of a first down. Bristol again opened up with its line-smashing tactics and made four first downs in succession, to reach Langhorne's eight-yard line as the whistle sounded, ending the contest.
