

'Star Gridders Dinner Guest

Bob Casciola, end coach at Princeton University, will be the guest speaker tonight when the Courier-Times honors the 28 boys who were recently named to the newspaper's All-Lower Bucks County Football Squad with a dinner at Pennsbury Inn.

The banquet will pay tribute to the 20 boys chosen for the offensive and defensive units of the All-Star team and the eight others selected for the All-Section squads. Coaches of the 10 area teams and newspaper personnel will also attend the affair.

Casciola joined the Princeton coaching staff shortly after graduation in 1958 as an assistant freshman coach. During his playing days for the Tigers he was

selected as an All-Ivy League tackle. He has been varsity end coach since 1961. During the spring he serves as freshman lacrosse mentor.
