

# Savage Running By 'S' Boys Pace Neshaminy's 55-0 Romp

The William Tennent fans found out why Neshaminy's Jack Stricker is called the Mr. Inside and Outside of Lower Bucks County League football.

In Saturday's league contest before 1,000 fans who braved the rain and cold weather, Stricker scored touchdowns the first three times he carried the ball in the first quarter and then crossed the goal line again in the third quarter to lead the Redskins to an over-whelming 55-0 win over Tennent.

The 55 points was the highest number of points scored by any team in Lower Bucks competition this season and brought the 1960 Neshaminy contingent closer to the overall scoring record of the league.

## Sixth Straight

It was the sixth straight circuit triumph for coach John Petercuskie's team, it being in a deadlock with Bensalem for top position. Overall, the 'Skins have an 8-0-1 record, Tennent is now 2-4-0 in the league and 3-5-0 over all.

It was Stricker and the other pair of the S-attack that paved the way for the easy win. Stricker had four touchdowns, Harry Schuh counted twice and Bill Schemberg booted seven of his eight placement tries to give him 30 for the season. Franny McCollum and Johnny Buhner made the other touchdowns.

But Stricker was sensational as he scored on runs of 52, 43, 37 and 26 yards. He also had two other carries of seven and eight yards to give him a 29 yards per try average for the afternoon. Petercuskie had him on the bench most of the time after the second quarter.

## Inside And Outside

Stricker started his runs through the line and then swung to the outside where he picked up Schuh for interference and after the coast was cleared easily outran the Tennent secondary.

Neshaminy scored on the first time from scrimmage as it netted 63 yards in four plays with Stricker going the final 52 through tackle and then along the right sidelines.

Neshaminy took possession on the Tennent 43 following a kick. Moments later and on the first play Stricker jetted his way to a touchdown. It was practically the same thing on the last play of the quarter as the Redskins took over on the 38 and after McCollum picked up a yard, Neshaminy's flying demon went the rest of the way without a hand being laid on him.

In the second quarter, it was Schuh's turn. Things happened quickly as the kickoff went to the Tennent 18 and Johnny Buhner fell on the free ball to give the 'Skins possession. Schuh skirted end for 15 yards and then leaped over for the score. The fifth touchdown was easy as a Tennent kick went to the Neshaminy 65 and from here Hammering Harry put on the Stricker - act and outran the secondary for the score.

A bum boot went to the Neshaminy 28 in the third period and after Joe Rothrock picked up two yards, Stricker galloped the other 26 for the touchdown.

It only took two plays for a march of 43 yards for the next TD. McCollum ran 14 yards on the first play and then skirted

end for 29 on the next play to cross the goal - line.

Right after the kickoff, the Neshaminy boys scored again to end the scoring. Frank Bachich had just clipped off 14 yards on a nice run and then attempted to hit Bob Zweitzig with a pass. But Buhner leaped up and caught the ball and went 44 yards for the touchdown.

Tennent was knocking on the door in the last quarter, getting to Neshaminy's four before losing the ball on downs.
