

# Neshaminy Beats Southampton, 32-8

## Faunce Paces Air Attack; Cameron Scores Three TD's

When the enemy and weather elements stop your ground attack then turn to your air attack.

That fighting technique was used by Neshaminy's coach Harry Franks as his talented Redskins made it five straight in the Lower Bucks County League by whipping Southampton High, 32-8, on the latter's field, Saturday.

It was also the seventh consecutive seasonal win for Neshaminy and 26th out of its last 27 games since Franks took over the coaching reins in 1952.

For Southampton, it was its fourth league loss and sixth of the season. The only win for the Greyhounds was against Pennsbury.

Neshaminy's great grid machine scored in every period, chalking up a pair of TD's in the second session and one in each of the others. Dashing Don Cameron started the scoring with a back-breaking 80 yard touchdown run on the opening kickoff.

### Second Team

Both Southampton scores, a touchdown and safety, were made in the final quarter, one being a 60-yard broken field run by Jerry Brigham. The run was against the Neshaminy second team.

Neshaminy only gained 67 yards on the ground because of the slippery ground and the fast charging Southampton line. However, in the air the victors made decided progress with 221 yards gained with this power. Most of the Neshaminy first downs were through the air.

### Passes

In addition to his 80-yard touchdown runback, Cameron scored two other touchdowns on long passes by Faunce. The other scores were to Monty Ahlum on a pass-lateral and Joe Moronese on a short line buck. The latter also had two conversions.

The Cameron touchdowns and the one by Moronese enabled them to lighten the Lower Bucks race for scoring honors. Morrisville's Arvie Powell is still leading the group with 57 points. Moronese has 56 and Cameron, 54.

### Faunce

Pitching for three touchdown passes was Faunce who is turning out to be the best pass-thrower in the area. Long or short, Faunce continues to hit his

mark. He completed seven of his 11 aeriels and those that missed were straight and true but the receiver was not prepared. One of Faunce's touchdown passes to Cameron covered 40 feet in the air and Cameron only had to step off four yards to score.

Coach Franks used a total of 35 players in the tilt using two full team substitutions. On one occasion at the start of the final period, one of the moves back-fired when Jerry Brigham slipped through the line and outran the secondary for the lone Southampton touchdown.

Although it ended up with 11 first downs, Neshaminy failed to register a first down in the first period. In fact when Cameron was forced to kick midway in the quarter, it was the first boot by Neshaminy in three games. Neshaminy only gained seven yards in the first quarter although Cameron's touchdown run-back gave it a 6-0 lead.

### MIs

Monty Ahlum missed a scoring chance when he dropped an interception of a pass on the 25 with a clear field ahead of him and a teammate for interference.

Neshaminy went 30 yards for its second score, a pass, Faunce to Ahlum for 18 yards aiding. Moronese made the score from the 44-yard line and then missed the conversion try.

To score its third touchdown, the Neshaminy boys traveled 67 yards. The TD was again set up with a 31-yard pass, thrown by the southpaw Cameron to Ahlum. It was scored when Faunce threw to Cameron for 39 yards.

Neshaminy missed a touchdown midway in the third session when

it drove from its 35 to the Southampton three with a 34 yard Faunce to Covington pass helping. But there was a fumble and Jerry Brigham recovered for Southampton.

Southampton punted from its dangerous position to the 48 from where it scored on three plays to make it 26-0 as a Faunce to Cameron pass covered 44 yards as the session ended.

Following the touchdown kickoff, Jerry Brigham made his 60 yard dash for the Southampton touchdown but shortly after Neshaminy closed its scoring with a pass-lateral touchdown. A 15-yard penalty had set back the Redskins to their 46. Faunce passed to Stan Covington on the Southampton 40. Covington did not attempt to run but immediately lateraled to Ahlum who went the remaining distance for the score.
