

# 'Skins Score Nine TD's Against Rams

Neshaminy High School scored early and often to completely humble Woodrow Wilson High, 59-0, before 2200 fans last night at Langhorne.

The Redskins of Neshaminy wasted no time in starting. Fleet Jack Stricker took the opening kickoff and roared 84 yards to score standing up with just 19 seconds gone in the game.

Stricker's scoring thrust opened the gates for a complete rout in the initial meeting between the two schools.

Neshaminy struck with power from all angles and even with the starting varsity resting on the benches, the score still climbed.

Foghorn Eddie Kaminski took the "blue ribbon" for scoring as he sped to three touchdowns in the fourth period. Before Kaminski's one-man show, Stricker and Harry Schuh divided up four touchdowns between themselves.

### Fiorelli Scores ...

The scoring parade was long for the "Rough Riders". Other markers were recorded by Ed (Bo) Fiorelli and Tom Rickards.

The Golden Rams of Woodrow Wilson never seriously threatened and could not contain Neshaminy in any way, shape or form.

Wilson's lopsided loss did not come from sloppy play, however.

Neshaminy backs raced through holes and just poured on the steam to out distance all defenders.

Schuh increased his league point production by 12 points and now has 46 markers in four outings. Stricker, who scored twice before "Hammering" Harry dented the column, helped his cause with two touchdowns for 26 counters in four tests.

Kaminski, who weights 150-pounds, became involved in the league scoring race with three six-pointers.

Neshaminy is now 5-1 in all games this year and has a perfect 4-0 loop apron. Coach Dick Nortrup's Rams are winless in three conference frays.

### Plenty of Points

Always-winning Neshaminy has ripped its LBCL record for eight seasons to a healthy 49-2-2 record. The "Rough Riders" are going scoring crazy. They now have 200 points in six games. Defensively, the "Skins have given up one touchdown in four league matches and a total of 26 points in all games.

Neshaminy's balanced air-ground attack was just too much for the Rams to handle. Johnny Kurtz connected on five tosses for 163 yards in the air. The running attack garnered 206 lengths.

Ken Dynan, Jack Scarbrough and Harry Ringden did most of Wilson's work on offense and defense but it wasn't enough. The Rams never put together a true scoring threat although Dynan threatened to break loose on several kickoffs.

the right direction by returning the kickoff 84-yards. Bob Ramsey missed the conversion but the pattern of the game had been established.

The race from goal line to goal line by Neshaminy was on and it was only a matter of time to see how high the score would soar.

Stricker struck again in the first period. He took a screen pass from Kurtz and barreled 50 yards to tally. Ramsey then converted for a 13-0 lead.

The first period was still on when Fiorelli bagged a Kurtz heave in the open and legged it 60 yards to net a six-pointer.

### Schuh Goes Wild

Schuh took over in the second period. He reeled in another Kurtz toss and rolled 32 yards through lots of traffic to score. With 5:15 left in the session Schuh barged over from the one and Ramsey connected for a 33-0 lead.

Neshaminy, knowing the game was no longer, or never was in doubt, cleared the regulars and in came the subs.

In the third period a mixture of first string boys kept things rolling and Rickards smacked a yard to score.

The fourth period saw Redskin big guns padlocked to the sides but Wilson still could not hold the second unit. Kaminski shook loose for runs of 14, 29 and 47 to push the score still higher.

Ramsey ended the night with five PAT's in nine attempts.
