Last year the addition of All-Section One and All-Section Two teams gave the Courier-Times All-Lower Bucks County Football Squad a new look.

This season still a new wrinkle has been added: The individual sections remain the same, but the overall squad for the first Lower Bucks County League team and Bishop Edgar High has been converted to offensive and defensive units.

The Courier-Times All Lower Bucks County Football Squad, published today, was selected from the top 10 high school football players, and members of the Courier-Times sports department.

Cummings Repals

Four boys who were honored last year on the first and second teams have been selected again. Neshaminy's Bob Cummings, who was named to the United Press International All-

State first team, is a repeater of center on this year's offensive team.

Bishop Egan's Al Pezola, a second team choice in 1961, was named to the backfield for the offensive unit. Barry Yeager of Council Rock, another second team backfield choice last year, was named to the defensive unit this time as a linebacker.

Guard Howard Dimter of Council Rock, a second team selection in 1961, failed to make either the first team on offense or defense, but was selected on

All-Section Two team.

Two-Way Performers

Two graders tackle Bill Elder of Delbasas and halfback Charlie Madie of Bensalem were the only two to be named to both the offensive and defensive stevedores.

Neshaminy, the perennial football power in these parts, walked off with five starting linemen on offense and added three more on defense.

On the offensive unit, Neshaminy placed Ed Mitchell, guard

three Galvin, halfback Bob Barras, in addition to Cummings.

ounding out the offensive unit, besides the Neshaminy players Elder, Madie and Pezola are end Dave Yates and guard Mike Yatsko of Bensalem and quarterback Jack Kiebe of Bensalem.

One Junior, One Soph

All on the offensive team are excellent blockers as a junior, Kiebe, a sophomore. On defense, Neshaminy placed Rich Lauther at end, who

was the only unanimous choice. He gained all 13 votes.

On the offensive squad, Yates and Barras won easily at end, but Michael and Elder just nipped Ahrens at tackle. Yatsko and Galvin were easy winners at guard and center was just one vote shy of being unanimous.

Boke Edges Penn

Kiebo just edged Penn for the quarterback post by one vote. Madie got 11 of a possible 16 votes in the backfield and Pezola was next with seven.

On the defensive side, Lauther and Webb were easy winners at end. Ahrens and Elder won the tackle posts, but Ken Meelin of Pennsylvanian received a lot of support. Pezola was the lone guard chosen, getting seven votes.

Penn and Yeager were easy winners at linebacker, but it took a runoff for Yeager to get the nod over Tempest's Steve Boston for the third spot in the deep secondary. Horvath, Barr and Madie won by comfortable margins.

WBA Names Clay Boxer Of Month

MANILA (UPI)—Heavyweight contender Cassius Clay of Louisville, Ky., who modestly claims he's the world's best fighter, was recognized today by the World Boxing Association as "Fighter of the Month" at age 20.

And the 25-year-old Louisville Jay, who moved from seventh to fourth among contenders in the WBA's latest rankings, beat out Archie Moore of Los Angeles, Nov. 15.

Moore, 41, was dropped from sixth to 10th in the rankings announced here in Manila by Anthony Petronella of Providence, R.I., chairman of the WBA Ratings Committee, who is visiting in the Philippines.
