LANGHORNE, Sept. 13 — A speedy halfback with the appropriate name of Reggie Jett sprinted for two third-period touchdowns to give Pennridge High a 13-0 upset victory over Neshaminy tonight.

The Rams ended Neshaminy's 16-game winning streak and avenged a 19-0 loss to the Lower Bucks champs last year.

Fans Watch in Rain

A crowd of 3,500 sat through a steady drizzle to see the opening game for both teams.

Jett, who picked up 104 of Pennridge's 206 yards in 13 carries, sliced off tackle from the 2 for the first touchdown.

With 16 seconds left in the third quarter, he broke loose on the

same play and ran 33 yards for his second score. After whipping through the hole for 10 yards, Jett cut to the right and outran the Redskin defenders. Bob Souder converted.

Mighty Mites

Pennridge's line, although outweighed, put the clamps on the Redskins, holding them to 100 yards rushing and 20 passing.

Neshaminy's biggest threat was in the second quarter but Barry Yoder, Pennridge center, stopped it by intercepting a pass on the 10 after the Redskins moved the ball 66 yards.

In the first quarter Pennridge got as far as the Neshaminy 2 after Jett recovered Al Gaskill's fumble on the Neshaminy 25 on the opening kickoff.

Touchdown Path

Pennridge went 51 yards for its first touchdown with Jett going 21 and 2 in two attempts and Ray Clemmer running 24 and 2 to set up the touchdown play on the 2.

Clemmer, who gained 58 yards in 8 carries, returned a punt 17 yards to the Neshaminy 45 to start the Rams rolling to their second score.
