

Bensalem Wins 3d Straight Title

Bensalem won its third straight Lower Bucks County Conference football title yesterday by beating its closest challenger, Neshaminy, 25-7, at Langhorne. Morrisville tied Bristol, 14-14, at Bristol and Council Rock outscored Southampton, 14-7, at Langhorne.

Bot Whitfield's passes gave Bensalem a 12-0 halftime edge. He pitched to Al Bader for 23 and John Mellor for seven. Two long runs with recovered fumbles featured the closing half. Neshaminy's Len Maurer race 58 to score and the victors' Jim Dwyer went 48 into the end zone.

LOEFFLER STARS

Bristol built up a 14-0 lead on Lou Loeffler's pass to Andy Accardi for 60 yards and Loeffler's nine-yard dash. But Morrisville came back in the final period on close-up plunges by Tommy Scott that ended drives of 83 and 61 yards.

Southampton stepped off to a 7-0 lead on Howard Teak's two-yard plunge to finish a 47-yard advance, but Council Rock tied it up in the last period on George Ettinger's close-up buck that polished off a 40-yard drive, and won with two minutes left. Charles Hauler blocked Teak's kick on the losers' 20 and Ettinger finally went over from the two.
