A 6-foot-1 running back and cornerback, Vincent rushed for 176 yards to lead the Redskins to a 35-7 win Friday over Suburban One National rival Truman. Vincent, 18, of Langhorne, had scoring runs of 29, 12, and 5 yards in the win, bringing his season total to 10 touchdowns. He has 678 yards rushing this season. Vincent transferred to Neshaminy last year from Malvern Prep. He is the second cousin of Philadelphia Eagles defensive back Troy Vincent, a Pennsbury graduate, and he also plays basketball and is a sprinter on the track team.
