Two former area coaches—John Petercuskie and Jackie Swartz—helped Neshaminy High School of Langhorne, Pa., win its second straight Lower Bucks County title on Thanksgiving Day when the team defeated Bensalem, 10-6.

Petercuskie, former assistant football coach at Old Forge High School, is line coach at the school while Swartz, ex-Carbon-dale High School head coach, is an assistant and also handles the junior high school eleven which posted a 5-1 record, losing only to Bristol, 20-18, which cost them the championship. Swartz also is baseball and wrestling coach.

The varsity football team has won 17 straight and has a 35-6 record in the last five years.
